

Ship Gov Group Cruising off Gallapagos

Remarks on board Wednesday Jan 7
Light breeze steering N.W. at 2 P.M. saw
land at 7 set shore watches and lay about
at day light stood in for Charles Island

Thursday Jan 8
First part light breeze being off 3 on
at Charles Island Capt. Mott on shore
I came off at 2 at 7 P.M. stood off
steering N.W. broke out for Molokai at
day light stood in for Albenack

Friday Jan 9
Fresh S.E. breeze being off 8 on South Head
saw two boats in shore fishing at 4 P.M.
boats came on board spoke Henry Clay
of Nantucket 38 months out with 1000
at 6 A.M. saw sperm whales lowered
& struck one took him along side
side & commenced cutting

Saturday Jan 10
Moderate breeze at 7 P.M. finished cutting
and set boiling watches latter part all hands
employed in boiling at 10 saw sperm whale
lowered struck eye & killed him took him
along side 1-25

Sunday Jan 11
Moderate breeze at 1 P.M. struck
111 whale at 3 took him along side
commenced cutting at 4 finished cutting
one & commenced boiling at 7 A.M. commenced
cutting spoke the Martha of Fair Haven
38 months out 1300 sperm

Monday Jan 12
At 8 A.M. finished cutting latter part
all hands employed for clearing up decks
& boiling saw a ship to windward

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Remarks on board Tuesday Jan 13
First part off sea breeze with fresh breeze
all hands employed clearing up decks &
boiling saw a ship to windward
latter part broke out for casks saw black

Wednesday Jan 14
Fresh breeze all hands breaking
out casks & boiling latter part moderate
saw black

Thursday Jan 15
This day of weather was jammed with
the Martha at 7 P.M. could do down latter
part all hands stowing down saw 3 sails

Friday Jan 16
Fresh breeze stowing down jammed
with the Martha Park & Anthony of
N.B. 26 months out with 600 sperm & the
Young Jones of Nantucket latter part
light breeze employed in stowing down

Saturday Jan 17
First part light breeze jammed with
Martha hatches latter part stowing
between decks

Sunday Jan 18
Off by day finished stowing between
decks latter part calm lowered for black
fish saw 4 sails

Monday Jan 19
First part light breeze jammed with
the Martha latter part set topmast
standing sail steering N.W.

Tuesday Jan 20
Light breeze jammed with Pantheon went into
North Head fishing latter part Hove after hove
