Remark Wednesday Jan 21 1852
First part calm two boats went to
Rockgun der fishing & one boat lowered
for black fish latter part moderate
breeze steering N. all hands employed in
washing ship.

Thursday Jan 22
First part fresh breeze steering N.
employed in washing ship latter part
washed ship out side.

Friday Jan 23
First part moderate breeze steering west
finished washing ship latter part watch
employed in mending main topsail.

Saturday Jan 24
First part light breeze mending main
topsail at 5 P.M. raised spinn. Whales
lowered & chased till sunset latter part
mending sail heading S.W. by W. long 74.

Sunday Jan 25
First part light breeze heading S.W.
employed in mending sail: breaking
out for water at 3 P.M. lowered for black fish
struck one took him along side latter part
steering S.W. by W.

Monday Jan 26
First part moderate breeze steering
S.W. by S. at 5 P.M. shortened sail &
boat crew patches at daylight made
sail all hands employed in breaking
out & coopers meat.

Tuesday Jan 27
Moderate breeze heading S.W. by S.
shortened sail at sundown & made it
again at daylight all hands coopers meat.

Remarks on board Wednesday Jan 28
First part moderate breeze heading S.W.
all hands employed in breaking out &
coopers meat latter part all hands
break out shook.

Thursday Jan 29
Moderate breeze heading S.W. by W.
employed in breaking out shook
at 5 P.M. lowered for black fish morning
sail latter part steering N.W. watch
employed in stowing away shook.

Friday Jan 30
Light breeze steering N.W. employed
in stowing away shook latter part
break out shook.

Saturday Jan 31
First part light breeze steering N.W.
stowing away shook latter part
made sail at 5 A.M. saw sperm
Whale lowered & struck three
at 12 took them along side at 6 P.M.

Sunday Feb 1
At 5 P.M. finished cutting saw
Whales lowered struck one took him
along side at 5 set boiling watches
at 8 P.M. commenced cutting.

Monday Feb 2
First part finished cutting & set
the works saw black fish all hands
steering N.W. deck & boiling latter part

Tuesday
First part moderate breeze steering
S.W. by S. employed in breaking out
for cask & boiling latter part heading S.W. by S.
