Fore part light breeze with rain steering
by N 1/2 N made a potato pond
lat 17.26 latter part light breeze & calm
engaged in picking old iron

Friday March 5th

Fore part light breeze from S & E
steering by N 1/2 N employed in picking
long 146.50 old iron latter part light breeze steering
lat 17.57 by N employed in scraping & painting
old iron

Saturday March 6th

Fore part light breeze from S & Westward
steering by N employed in scraping &
painting old iron latter part fresh breeze
lat 18.07 from N & steering by N finished scraping
& painting iron work broke out for making stoves

Sunday March 7th

Fore part fresh breeze from N & steering by N
rove new topsail halysed latter part
fresh breeze saw nothing

Monday March 8th

Fore part fresh breeze from N & steering
by N 1/2 N latter part light breeze

Tuesday March 9th

Fore part moderate breeze from N & E
with rain steering by N 1/2 N at 7 double
reefed topsails & halysed to wind at 5 AM
made sail steering by N 1/2 N

Wednesday March 10th

Fore part squally with rain at 1 PM
Ouzhu at 2 made round heading N & low
wind latter part wind from S W with
rain steering by N 1/2 N saw a sail

Fore part wind from S W rain with
squalls saw Noed latter part fresh breeze
with some rain saw a ship
went flying jib

Friday March 12th

Fore part strong breeze from N
steering to windward took in fore &
lat 20.45 mizen top gal in sail latter part

Saturday March 13th

Fore part strong breeze steering
& windward latter part strong breeze
beating up between Kani & Tavora
by saw the

Sunday March 14th

Fore part strong breeze beating
to windward saw the first of Tahiti
at 10 AM come to anchor

Monday March 15th

Fore part took a raft of coals on shore to
fill & brought off 30 bush of meat latter part
got off a raft of water

Tuesday March 16th

Fore part water went on liberty
starboard watch employed in painting
ship

Wednesday March 17th

Starboard watch on liberty starboard
watch employed in painting ship

Thursday March 18th

Starboard watch on liberty starboard watch
employed in stowing the water & getting
a raft of coals on shore

Friday March 19th

Starboard watch on liberty starboard
watch employed in stowing water &
getting a small raft on shore
