Remark Saturday Mch 20th
All hands employed in towing off & stowing
down water

Remark Sunday Mch 21st
Strong breeze from S.W. at 10 A.M. let
go Portward anchor double reefed topsails
at 10 A.M. wind died away

Monday Mch 22nd
Four part hove up Starboard anchor all hands
employed in stowing water & jet the sub

Tuesday Mch 23rd
Starboard watch on liberty. Portward
watch got off a raft of water & stowed it

Wednesday 24th
Starboard watch on liberty

Thursday 25th
Took on board 10 bbl potatoes

Friday 26th
Got off a small raft of water

Saturday 27th
At 2 P.M. got under way for Port (breeze
with rain)

Sunday 28th
First part light breeze steering for Calcutta

Monday 29th
Four part strong N.E. trade at 10 A.M.
up with Diamond Head took in light sail
going off & on at 1 P.M. Capt. sight on shore

Tuesday Mch 30th
Four part strong breeze going off & on all day with
Capt. on shore

Wednesday Mch 31st
Strong trade at 4 P.M. Capt. came off
squared away & set studding sail steering N.E.

Got the anchors on the bow latter part steering N.E.

Thursday April 1st
Strong breeze steering N.E. middle part took in top
gallant sail latter part steering N

Remark on board Friday April 2nd 1852
Four part blowing a gale from E. Starboard steering N
at 2 P.M. took in top gallant sail & double reefed topsails
at 4 took in mainsail & jib four muzzed topsails
latter part strong breeze steering N

Saturday April 3rd
Four part strong breeze from S.W.
steering N by N latter part broke out
slope

Sunday April 4th
Four part fresh breeze from N.E. steering
N by N employed in cleaning the pots
latter part wind from S.W.

Monday April 5th
Four part strong wind from N.N.W.
heading N. double reefed topsails latter
strong breeze from northward broke
out for looks

Tuesday April 6th
Four part strong breeze from
northward heading N. broke out in
the main hatch for heads & hoops
latter part strong breeze from N.E.

Wednesday 7th
Four part strong breeze from N.E. &
with rain steering N.N.W. under double
reefed fore & main topsails & foresail latter
part set the mainsail & jib & main
top gallant sail

Thursday 8th
Four part strong breeze from N.E. steering
N by N double reefed topsails took in
mainsail & muzzed topsails latter part wind
from northward heading N.N.W. broke out water

Friday April 9th
Four part strong breeze from N.E. steering N.N.W.
latter part no wind breeze & saw nothing
