

Ship Cove Group Cruising in Bannockburn Sea

Remarks on board Thursday May 27th 1852

One port light breeze from N & westward heading N & eastward spoke the *James Edward* of New London latter port light breeze from westward steering to northward at 11 A.M. made Cape Bald Head.

Friday May 28th

One port very light breeze from westward standing in to land watch employed in mending South gillnet sail latter port light breeze standing in.

Saturday May 29th

One port light breeze with fog at 4 P.M. gillnet away steering S.E. saw nothing latter port light breeze & sail.

Sunday May 30th

One port light breeze from eastward & Bannockburn spoke the *Alce Crania* of N.B. 9 months out clean & *Enterprise* of N.B. latter port fresh breeze saw nothing.

Monday May 31st

One port strong breeze from southward steering S & westward gillnet with *Alce Crania* spoke the bark *Newton Peck* just from northward saw plenty of ships & ice there but no whales latter port strong breeze steering S.E. saw 2 sails.

Tuesday May 31st

One port strong breeze from N & westward heading westward saw 2 sails latter port steering S.E. at 11 A.M. saw Bearings island.

Wednesday 30th

One port fresh breeze steering to southward spoke the *Liverpool* of N.B. saw Copper Island latter port strong breeze spoke the *Charles Carroll* of New London bound westward.

Ship Cove Group bound Northward

Remarks Thursday May 26th 1852

One port strong breeze from S & westward heading S & eastward gillnet away the jib latter port light breeze from westward heading southward.

Friday May 27th

One port light breeze from westward heading southward saw a ship latter port strong breeze from N.E. steering S.W. by N.

Saturday May 28th

One port strong breeze from N.E. standing S.W. saw right whale toward but did not strike latter port wind from southward heading S.W. lowered for right whale saw a ship.

Sunday May 29th

One port fresh breeze from southward with fog heading S.W. at 7 P.M. reefed top sails latter port strong breeze from westward heading southward.

Monday May 30th

One port strong breeze from southward heading to southward at 10 P.M. gillnet away latter port light breeze with thick fog heading S.W.

Tuesday June 1st

One port light breeze with fog heading westward at 1 saw land latter port thick fog heading S.W. westward.

Wednesday June 2nd

One port strong breeze from S & eastward heading eastward under double reefed top sail & foresail with thick fog came very near being run into by the *Meridian* of New York latter port strong breeze.

Thursday June 3rd

One port fresh breeze from southward heading S.W. back out for corn latter port light breeze steering S.W. saw land.
