

Ship Gov. Crook Cruising in the Ochotk Sea

Remarks on board Friday June 18th

One part fresh breeze with rain steering westward
gammed with the St George latter part heading
northward saw the land

Saturday June 19th

One part fresh breeze from westward steering
to northward gammed with St George & Metacomb
latter part light breeze saw nothing

Sunday June 20th

One part light breeze from St George for
a ripack latter part wind from southward
with thick fog lying with head to back

Monday June 21st

One part light breeze from southward with thick
fog heading off shore latter part thick fog saw a
ship

Tuesday June 22nd

One part light breeze from St George standing
off & on with rain & fog latter part light breeze
from northward steering in for the land

Wednesday June 23rd

One part light gammed with the St George
& bark Mount Walliston at 11 steering to
latter strong wind from St George heading
with fog & rain

Thursday June 24th

One part strong wind with rain & fog took
out for head & floor latter part light wind
from northward heading off

Friday June 25th

One part light breeze heading off saw a
ship latter part light breeze at 5 A.M. lowered for
a ripack & came on board at 1. At 11 lowered
again & low boat struck one & parted

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Remarks on board Saturday June 26th

One part light breeze steering N.W. came along in
within 1/2 m & scraping bone

Sunday June 27th

One part light breeze steering N.W. finish
high scraping bone saw land latter part fresh
breeze from eastward heading in for the land

Monday June 28th

One part strong breeze from eastward looking
windward saw a ship gammed with this
latter part strong breeze from northward at 6 A.M.
boarded & low boat went in to the land at 11
came to anchor

Tuesday June 29th

One part strong wind from northward
employed in trying out at 1 P.M. boat came
off saw 3 or 4 whales in shore latter part strong
wind & boat in shore lowered from the
ship & struck a whale belonging to the Alaska
& returned in ship

Wednesday June 30th

One part 2 boats in shore took the windlog
boat taking the anchor kept went on board
the Florida latter part 2 boats went in
shore capt came on board & took the anchor

Thursday July 1st

One part light breeze heading off saw a ship
boat in shore finished boiling latter
part came to anchor 3 boats in shore
