Remarks on board Monday Aug 1st
One part cabin chased whale. Deck
fresh breeze employed in stowing down & securing board

Civil time Tuesday August 2nd
No fresh breeze beating to windward & chased
whales sun in sight take one

Civil time Tuesday Aug 3rd
Moderate breeze from N.W. at 11 AM
lowered for whales & struck one &
killed him took him along side &
cut him in at 3 PM lowered &
took another and got him along
side at 6 & commenced cutting

Wednesday Aug 4th
Light breeze from N.W. at 11 AM
cutting & commenced hoisting at 1 PM
lowered & took another & got a boat
stove got him along side at 3 PM
cutting finished at 11 PM

Thursday Aug 5th
Light breeze from S.W. at 10 AM
lowered for whales struck one
turned him up got a boat stove
took him along side commenced
cutting at 1 PM at 11 PM

Friday Aug 6th
Fresh breeze from S.W. at 11 AM
commenced cutting again at 11 AM
cutting spoke the St George (after)
strong breeze took in fore & mizzen
topsails & double reefed main

Saturday Aug 7th
All hands employed in stowing
down & hoisting

Remarks Sunday Aug 8th
Cloudy with a moderate breeze from
the W. S.W. all hands hoisting
& sail in sight Monday Aug 9th

Light breeze from W. S.W. with
passing squall of fog employed
in hoisting & stowing down

Tuesday Aug 10th
Breeze with light breeze stowing
down & hoisting Wednesday Aug 11th

Thursday Aug 12th
Light breeze from N.E. at 11 AM
fog cleared up at 1 PM at 1 PM
hoisting all hands employed in securing
board at 2 PM spoke the St George
breeze sprang up double reefed the top sail

Friday Aug 13th
Strong breeze from N.E. at 11 AM
at 12 PM spoke the Metacom at 1 PM
lowered for whales - rising

Saturday Aug 14th
Fresh breeze from N.E. at daylight
lowered two boats and pulled in shore at 10
came on board all hands employed in
stowing oil between decks at 4 lowered
for whales

Sunday Aug 15th
Calmer weather scraping bone & chasing
whales three ships in sight Monday Aug 16th
Foggy with strong breeze from S.W. whales double
reefed topsails at 11 AM fog lit up lowered for whales
