

Ship Co. Group Cruising in the Gulf

Tuesday Aug 17th
Calm weather chasing whales & storing oil

Wednesday Aug 18th
Light breeze from N.E. at 11 AM Capt went
on shore with 2 boats at 2 PM found hauls
to southward with rain

Thursday Aug 19th
Light breeze from S with rain. I fired the
gun for the boats she went off while loading
the 2nd time I put the blacksmith & steward at 4
AM boats came off with two boat loads
of fish. Later part calm Friday Aug 20th

Light breeze from N.E. heading N.N.W. saw
a sail

Saturday 21st
Light breeze from N.E. standing on reef
tacks. Toward forenoon saw two ships at
anchor in shore which proved to be the St
George & Coral at 8 anchored in 16 fathoms water
about 2 miles from the land. Jamming all
night with the Coral. Sunday 22nd

at 6 AM two boats went in shore at 10 AM
encircling blowing from the S.W. the boats
came on board & began to get under weigh took
the anchor & double reefed topsail at 3 PM

Monday 23rd
Strong breeze from S.W. standing on dipping
tacks. Saw 3 sails S.W. moderate breeze

Tuesday 24th
Light breeze from N.E. lowered for whales
at 11 AM light breeze from N.E. at 2 PM strong
breeze took in 1st & 2nd sails double reefed in
main sail & jib

Aug 25th
Moderate breeze from S.W. heading to
windward under double reefed topsail
one sail in sight

Wednesday Aug 26th
Strong breeze from S.W. heading
to windward employed in starting
water & storing bone

Friday Aug 28th
Light breeze from northward with
thick fog. Starting & watch employed
in storing off the blue pig iron

Saturday 29th
Light breeze from northward steering
off by N. & ships in sight 3 or 4
gammed with the St George

Sunday 29th
Light breeze from N.E. standing N
I.H. lowered for a bow haul. Jamming
with St George & Metacom at 7
thick fog

Monday Aug 30th
Moderate breeze from N. standing S.W.
at 6 AM fog cleared up sent a man
main topsail & foud sail at 8 PM. Saw
all land in sight & started

Tuesday Aug 31st
Light breeze from S.W. standing S.W.
watch employed in drying bone two
sails in sight

Wednesday Sept 1st
Strong breeze from S.W. heading
to windward. E. & S. spoke the Currier of N.Y. 11
whales this season. Thick fog

Thursday Sept 2nd
Moderate gale from S.W. heading
to windward at 2 PM came away the
main topsail yard sent it down &
commenced fitting a new one
