Friday Sept 3rd
Strong breeze from S.W. with rain & rain
too under double reefed main topsail & fore
sail reefed the fore sail & close reefed main
topsail. latter had sent up the fore topsail & set

Saturday Sept 4th
Strong breeze from Westward beating to
windward repaired the mizzen & main

Sunday Sept 5th
Strong breeze from N.W. standing on
different tacks. At 10 moderate east tacks
light sails & double reefed topsails took in
main sail & jib a sail in sight to
windward at 7 gammed off with the board

Monday Sept 6th
Fresh breeze from N.W. beating to
windward under all sail. At 10 light
breeze gamming with the board

Tuesday Sept 7th
Strong breeze from S.W. beating to
windward gamming with the board

Wednesday Sept 8th
Strong breeze from S.W. North for
took in top & bottom sail & reefed the
main sail & broke out for floor

Thursday Sept 9th
Strong breeze from Northward steering
N.W. at 10 a howl was sent down
the right whale spoke the Coriol. At 11
gammed with the board & began to spin sail

Friday Sept 10th
Light breeze from Northward shade sail
standing Westward 11 sails in sight
at 10

Remarks on board Saturday Sept 11th
Calin made sail. lowered the right
whales at 1 PM lowered again at 3 PM
struck one & turned him up at 4 took him
along side shortened sail

Sunday Sept 12th
Light breeze from Northward at 4
commenced cutting at 11 finished
cutting made sail standing to westward
at 8 shortened sail & started the works

Monday Sept 13th
Strong breeze from N.E. standing
to Westward double reefed topsails all hands
boiling & scraping bone at 10 lowered
the whales saw a sail today in sail

Tuesday Sept 14th
Calin further watch employed in sailing
at 11 light breeze from N.E. lowered for right
whales at 12 finished boiling

Wednesday Sept 15th
Light breeze from eastward heading
N.E. at 9 PM lowered for right whales
struck one & turned him up took him
along side at 12 & commenced cutting at 7 PM
finished cutting filled the tanks & shortened
sail

Thursday Sept 16th
Moderate breeze from N.E. heading N.W.
all hands boiling & bucking out shooks at
3 PM lowered for whales they hooked one &
drew spoke the off George stove at 4 PM
shortened sail

Friday Sept 17th
Moderate breeze from S.W. at 11 PM all
hands boiling & scraping bone boiling
lowered sunset time shortened sail
