Wednesday 13th
Moderate breeze from E heading N. E. by
broke out bottom & dried apples & other
fresh breeze took ship heading S by E
at 10 took in light sail

Thursday 14th
Strong breeze from N. E. heading S by E
at 10 AM in took in sail & then
most moderate breeze set the jib &
main sail wind hauled to N. N. W. made
sail steering S by E

Friday 15th
Strong breeze from N. E. steering
S by E at 4. A.M. took in light sail
at 10 made sail again P.M. broke out
Porter wind hauled to southward
at 4 48' N
Long 162° 24' W
