Remarks Saturday Jan 15
Strong breeze from N.W. steering S.W.
at 7 A.M. took in studding
sail carried away the flying jib boom
took in light sails & double reefed
at 7 P.M. light breeze made sail
employed in fitting the rigging
at 10 P.M. squally with rain. Sailed
with the bark Louisa Capt. H. J.
of N.B. 26 months out with 1200 H. 40 S.
bound home lat 14° 11' N

Sunday Jan 16th
Fresh breeze from N.W. heading S.W.
gunning with the bark

Monday Jan 17th
Light breeze from N.W. steering S.W.
I applied the flying jib boom & took
hoist raising the bark in sight at 11⁰⁰ A.M.

Tuesday Jan 18th
Fresh breeze from S.W. heading S.W.
watch employed in sending out
flying jib boom & changing the sail the bark
in sight lat 17° 43' N

Wednesday Jan 19th
Fresh breeze from S.W. heading S.W.
watch employed in fitting
the rigging fold the sheet & close of
glister Rosa at Antigua saw the bark

Thursday Jan 20th
Light breeze from S.W. standing
on different tack watch employed in
mending sprinker at 6 P.M. fresh breeze
from N.W. steering S.W. set studding
sails

Fresh breeze from N.W. steering S.W.
at 9 A.M. saw the Island of St. Vincent
one of the Leeward Islands at 12 sent 2 boats
on shore to trade for fruit got off three
boat loads saw the bark Louisa &
ship Metacomb going off voy. at 4 P.M.
put away for Antigua

Saturday Jan 22nd
Strong breeze from N.W. with
squally rain steering S.W. at 4 P.M.
saw the Island of St. Vincent too
I took in sails being slack through
the night spoke the Louisa

Sunday Jan 23rd
Strong breeze from N.W. with rain
at 6 P.M. light off steering S.W.
spoke the Louisa saw no land at 10
steering S.W. latter part took in
light sails & double reefed the Louisa
in company

Monday Jan 24th
Fresh breeze from N.W. with fine weather
at 6 A.M. made all sail at 10 P.M. wind
hauled N.E. took in studding sail

Tuesday Jan 25th
Fresh breeze from N.E. steering S.W. at 7
A.M. wind N.W. set studding sails
took the anchor on the bow lat 26° 06' N

Wednesday Jan 26th
Fresh breeze from N.W. steering S.W.
at 6 P.M. hauled to S.W. with rain
I took in light sails & double reefed
topsails lat 27° 53' N
