Remarks of the day Monday Feb 21
Strong breeze from W. by N. steering
W. by N. A M broke out water caught
a porpoise P M wet hold at 11 took in
studding sail main & fore & foretop
sails Lat 47° 41' S Long 118° 55' W.

Tuesday Feb 22
A M strong wind from W. by N. steering
E. by N. at 4 took in maintop & foretop
& double reefed topsail at 11 closed reefed
at 12 took in foretop sail & reefed foresail
blowing a gale P M moderated some at
6 set foresail & reefed foretop sail turned
our reef out of the main at 9 am a double
reefed fore & single reefed maintop sail & main
top gallant sail Lat 47° 32' S Long 114° 12' W.

Wednesday Feb 23
Strong wind from Westward steering
E. set studding sails & main & foretop
on & took them in again P M close reefed the
fore & double reefed the maintop sail Lat 47° 26' S Long 109° 26' W.

Thursday Feb 24
Strong breeze from Westward steering East
employed in making a lock. latter part
made all sail saw Grubbs at 4:45 Lat 48° 4' S Long 105° 15' W.

Friday Feb 25
Fresh breeze from W. steering E. at
employed in making a lock. to the
fore & aft something Lat 48° 37' S Long 100° 37' W.

Saturday Feb 26
Fresh breeze from W. by N. steering E. by N. saw
nothing set the studding sail & fore & foretop
sails Lat 50° 1' S Long 96° 43' W.

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Remarks Thursday Feb 27
A M fresh gale from Northward with rain
took in main sail jib & foretop sails double
reefed the main P M wind hauled to
Westward & moderated inside all sail parted
the ring to the clew of maintop sail Lat 51° 25' S Long 97° 42' W.

Monday Feb 28
Fresh breeze from W. by N. steering E. by N. at
12 M. unbutton the main topsail & bent a main
one P M strong breeze took in studding sail
& main & foretop sails at 17 Lat 52° 26' S Long 87° 26' W.

Tuesday Feb 29
A M fresh breeze mended foretop sail
steering E. by N. P M sent down foretop
& bent another at 5 saw a sperm whale
lowered 2 boats but did not get fast at
dark boat came on board & kept her off
steering E. Lat 53° 26' S Long 82° 31' W.

Wednesday March 1
A M fresh breeze from Northward steering
E. P M wind hauled W. by N. set
studding sails steering E. Lat 54° 26' S Long 78° 26' W.

Thursday March 2
Fresh breeze from W. by N. steering East
broke out water P M steady fresh
killed a hog Lat 55° 39' S Long 74° 37' W.

Friday March 3
A M light breeze from Northward steering
E. by N. P M fresh breeze from Westward
steering E. N. E. saw a sail

Sat Lat 56° 32' S Long 71° 05' W.
