

Ship Gov Group off Cape Horn 1853

Remarks of the day Mch 5th

A. M. strong breeze from N. N. W. steering N. E. by E. carried away the fore topmast standing sail boom & the wind from N. W. steering N. E. saw 2 ships bound westward & supposed to be Cape Horn. Lat 56° 34' long

Sunday Mch 6th

Fresh breeze from N. E. westward heading N. E. by E. Statenland in sight. Mch 6th Lat 54° 11' long 60° 50'

Monday Mch 7th

A. M. moderate breeze from westward heading N. by W. steering N. East standing sails broke out from & about 1/2 at 5 1/2. Lat 54° 11' long 60° 50'

Tuesday Mch 8th

Fore part strong breeze from N. N. W. steering N. E. took in light sails & double reefed topsail took in jib & took in main sail & main topsail & closed reefed fore topsail at 5 wind fresh N. by E blowing a gale. fore sail took in fore top sail & closed reefed main turned up starboard boat. Packed wheel & rope a new one a brig in sight steering N. E. by E. Lat 52° 47' long 57° 25'

Wednesday Mch 9th
A. M. blowing a gale from N. W. steering N. E. under closed reefed main topsail & reefed foresail at 12 shipped a sea carried away the round house & starboard monkey rail & M. moderate same set fore topsail whole main topsail & main top gallant sail steering N. N. E. at 9 steering N. E. Lat 51° 20' long

Remarks of the day Mch 10th

A. M. fresh breeze from N. W. steering N. E. set standing sail took in starboard & fore main & fore wind from westward at 1000 light breeze. Lat 48° 44'

Friday Mch 11th

A. M. strong breeze from N. Westward heading N. by E. under double reefed topsail & fore wind hauled & fore top blowing a strong gale called all hands to work fore topsail reefed the foresail & closed reefed main topsail steering N. E. at 9 steering N. E. by E.

Saturday Mch 12th

Strong breeze from S. by P. steering N. by E. shock out reef & set main top gallant sail & M. reefed fore topsail & took in main top gallant sail. Lat 44° 26' long 47° 00'

Sunday Mch 13th

Fore part fresh breeze from N. by E. steering North set standing sails & M. light breeze from N. N. W. heading North by East a small ship heading S. by E. Lat 41° 30' long 45° 29'

Monday Mch 14th

A. M. moderate breeze from N. N. W. heading N. by E. & N. N. E. broke out with wheat and wood & M. heading N. N. E. Lat 39° 15' long 44° 11'

Tuesday Mch 15th

A. M. moderate breeze from N. W. heading N. E. sent down main royal & work fitted it & set it up again & M. wind from N. by E. set & took sail heading N. by E. Lat 37° 20'
