Thursday July the 14. 1836
 These 24 hours Commences with
 strong Breeze from the ESE and
 hazy ship under all sail from the
 wind One employed on Ships Duty
 at 6 P.M. put anchor boat on the Grand
 Middle Part fish Breeze and hazy
 latter Part strong Breeze from the
 N.E. & E. Lat By obs 19° 13' Long 22° 21'

Friday July the 15. 1836
 These 24 hours Commences with strong
 Breeze from the N.E. & E. and clear weather
 ship under all sail free from the wind
 all hands employed on Ships Duty
 at 2.30 P.M. tuck in the Steering sail
 furl the fore and main Slooping sails
 Middle Part strong Breeze and hazy
 weather at 3 am Set the fore Sloop
 ast steering sail at 5 am main all
 sail Steady S.W. & S. latter Part hazy
 weather at 12. meridian main the island
 full Baring S.W. & S. Distance 15. miles
 Lat By obs 16° 45' Long 22° 36'

Saturday These 24 hours Commences with stro
 ng Breezes and thick weather ship under
 all sails reach employed on Ships
 Duty at 2 P.M. the ill of full Steer in
 light at 8 P.M. Stead S.E. Middle
 Part light Breeze and hazy weather
 latter Part light breeze and hazy
 Long 22. weather So ends these 24 hours Lat 18° 33'

Sunday These 24 hours Commences with light breeze
 from the N.E. & E. and hazy weather ship
 under all sails One employed on Ships Duty
 Middle Part light breeze and clear we
 ther latter Part heavy attended with Squalls

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Monday These 24 hours Commences with strong
 gales from the South and S.W. attended
 with heavy showers of rain blow the fore
 and main Slooping Sails Reel the
 main Slooping Ship heading W.B. at 2 P.M.
 let one Reel out the fore and main Slooping
 at 3.30 P.M. let one Reel out the fore and
 main Slooping Set fore and main at 8 P.M.
 let the Slooping sails Middle Part fine
 weather latter Part light Breeze and
 Pleasant Lat By obs 13° 13' Long 23° 01'

Tuesday These 24 hours Commences with light
 Breeze from the South and Pleasant
 weather ship under all sail by the wind
 reach employed on Ships Duty two sail
 in light at 6 P.M. tuck ship to the South
 wind W.S.W. at 9 P.M. Calm at 10.5 wore ship
 latter Part Calm at 6 am saw ashore to the N
 west latter Part light Breeze and flattening
 So ends these 24 hours Lat By obs 13° 05'

Wednesday These 24 hours Commences with light breeze
 from the S.E. and sultry ship under all
 sail One employed on Ships Duty at 2 P.
 M. set the fore Slooping steering sail and
 main Slooping Steer steering sail at 4 P.M.
 Calm at 6 P.M. tuck in the steering sail
 set down the Slooping sails hold up the
 fore and main Sails Middle Part Calm
 at 3 AM light Breeze from the N.W. & E. latter
 Part fresh breeze and cloudy Lat By obs 12° 50'

Thursday July the 21. These 24 hours Commences
 with fresh Breezes from the ESE and heavy
 ship under all sails reach employed on
 Ships Duty Middle Part Calm latter
 light Breeze and Pleasant weather
 So ends these 24 hours Lat By obs 12° 05'
