Wednesday These 24 hours Commences with light day Breeze from the North and Cloudy August Ship under all sail wach Employed the 31 Ships Duty Bent New Main Topsails at 4 P.M. set the Topgallin sail Middle Part Calm at 6 A.M. set the Storing Longitud Sails at 9 A.M. on Bent the Topsails 13.30 Latter Part light Breeze and Passing clouds So Ends these 24 hours Adols this day

Thursday These 24 hours Commences with brisk breeze from the NW and Passing clouds Ship Sept-Under all sail heading SE & B & wach Emp the 1st Loyed on Ships Duty at 6 P.M. shifted the Storing sails over on the larboard side at 8 P.M. took in the lower Storing sail Middle Part light breeze and squally at 3 A.M. took in the fore topmast Storing sail Latter Part Strong breeze and Passing clouds So Ends these 24 hours Lat By obs 37° 57'

Friday These 24 hours Commences with brisk Sept Breeze and Cloudy weather Ship under the 2nd All sail Repairing Ships Course SE & B & wind NW wach Employed on Repairing Longitud the Main Topsails at 5 P.M. set the 15.56 lower Storing sail at 6 P.M. then SE & E East Middle Part fresh breeze and Passing clouds Latter Part Strong breeze and thick weather So Ends these 24 hours Lat By obs 38° 35'

Saturday These 24 hours Commences with fresh Sept Breeze from the NW and Cloudy weather the 3rd Ship under all sail wach Employed on Ships 19.51 Duty Course SE & B & Middle Part light breeze and Passing clouds at 5 A.M. wind holding So the SE Breeze up Latter Part light breeze So Ends these 24 hours Lat By obs 37° 48' South

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Remarks on Board Sunday September the 4th These 24 hours Commences with light Breeze from the NE and Cloudy weather Longitud Ship under all sail Repairing one Employed 22.45 on Ships Duty Course SE & B & Middle East Part light Breeze and Rain at 2 A.M. Calm at 4 A.M. light breeze from the NE and Wisly Latter Part Continued the same So Ends these 24 hours Lat By obs 38° 51'

Remarks on Board Monday Sept the 5th These 24 hours Commences with fresh Breeze from the SE and Cloudy weather Ship under all sail By the wind at 6 P.M. took in the fore and Mizzen Topgallin sail and flying gill at 11 A.M. took in the Main Topgallin sail Middle Part Brisk breeze and Passing clouds at one A.M. wind holding So the 14.45 Pat 5 A.M. took the fore and Longitud Main Topsails and Clout the Mizzen Pops 22.21 and took in the gill and main sail East Latter Part Strong gale from the NW So Ends Lat By obs 38° 12'

Remarks on Board Tuesday September the 6th These 24 hours Commences with Strong Gales from the SE and Squally Ship under Double Reef Topsails Course SE & B & at 4 P.M. set the gill at 6 P.M. heavy gale Long took in the fore boat and turned up the west boat at 8 P.M. Clout Reef 25.21 the Topsails Middle Part Moderate East one Reef out of the Topsails at 4 A.M. set the Topgallin sails at 5 A.M. made all sail at 1 A.M. Put out the lower boat set the fore topmast Storing sail So Ends 37° 53'
