

Ship Grand Turk of Dartmouth

Saturday These 24 hours Commenced with
 October strong breezes from the NW and hazy
 the 1 all hands Employed on Ships Duty
 1836 getting ready for voyaging at 6 P.M.
 Tuck in the fore and Mizzen topsails
 and got under ship to the South and
 set the main voyaging Middle Part
 Thick Drizzly weather at 8 A.M. made
 sail stood to the SE & saw several
 hump back whale latter Part light
 breeze and hazy swell from the SW
 so ended this 24 hours Lat Byols 34° 57'

Sunday These 24 hours Commenced with light
 October breeze from the SE & and hazy
 the 2 all hands Employed in voyaging and
 all sail. Sailing all hands Employed
 in voyaging saw good many hump
 back at 3 P.M. saw one right whale
 board three boats did not get fast
 at 6 P.M. Tuck in sails headed to
 the Eastward Middle Part light breeze
 at 8 A.M. finished voyaging at 4.30 A.M.
 Had whale board got two barbed boat
 6.46 Struck side with the iron ~~the~~ mast
 boat struck bar boat side at 11.11
 Tuck them to the ship and Commenced
 cutting so ended Lat Byols - 34° 52'

Monday These 24 hours Commenced with breeze
 October from the NW all hands Employed
 in cutting at 4 P.M. finished cutting
 in one at 6 P.M. began voyaging ship
 Landed head NW Middle Part light breeze
 6.56 at 5 A.M. began cutting at 10 A.M.
 finished cutting at 11.2 began voyaging
 set and made sail latter Part light
 breeze so ended Lat Byols 34° 56'

Tuesday These 24 hours Commenced with
 October light breeze from the NW and
 fair weather ship under all sail
 Sailing headed to the Eastward all hands
 Employed on voyaging at three P.M. saw
 two right whale board three boats and
 Chast did not strike at 6 P.M. Tuck
 in sails and set the main Middle
 Part light breeze and Pleasant at 5 A.M.
 Made sail all hands Employed in making
 out at 9 A.M. saw whale board two boats
 and Chast did not strike Lat Byols 34° 56'

Wednesday These 24 hours Commenced with light
 October breeze from the NW ship headed
 all hands Employed in voyaging and
 down one sail in sight standing to
 the Eastward at 6 P.M. finished voyaging
 down and Tuck in sails and set the
 main at 12 midnight wore ship to the
 Northward and Eastward at 8 A.M. saw
 whale board the boats and Chast but did
 not strike at 9 A.M. set the fore and
 Mizzen topsail Quik Reef latter Part fresh
 breeze from the North Lat Byols 34° 59'

Thursday These 24 hours Commenced with fresh
 day from the North ship under all sail
 October Sailing all hands Employed on voyaging
 and standing down at 6 P.M. Tuck in
 sails ship headed NW wind North
 Middle Part fresh breeze and clear weather
 at one A.M. finished voyaging at 8 A.M. began
 standing down at 9 A.M. strong breeze and
 latter Part strong breeze from the
 Westward and drizzly weather so ended
 these 24 hours Lat Byols this day
