Thursday These 24 hours Commenced with
any Strong gales from the SW and thick
at 10 Weather cleared with light showers
the 13 of Home Ship under Closest Reef main
Topsails and fore and Mizzen Staysail
Ship head. 26 wack Employed in
Boysling Middle Part were moored
at 6 AM finished boyling and began stow-
ing down one sail in light - latter
Part light breeze and heavy sea
So ended these 24 hours Lat Byals 34° 56'

Friday These 24 hours Commenced with light
at 10 winds from the W-SW ship under Closest
the 14 Reef Topsails head 26 all hands Em-
ployed on stowing down at 6:30 PM
spoke the ship gorge of New London
with ten whales at 7 PM finished
stowing down at 8 AM set the wack
Boats crew at 9 PM were ship on Ben
Middle Part fish breeze and blowing
Weather at 5 AM made sail and
steared to the Northward and westward
three sails in light all hands Employed
in craping Boon at 4 PM took in
sail head to the So ended these 24
hours Lat Byals - 34° 24'

Saturday These 24 hours Comd with brisk from
any the westward and passing clouds
at 10 ship under all sail all hands Emp-
loyed on sweeping Boon at 7 PM took
in sail head to the westward
Middle Part light breeze and Pleasant
at 5 AM made sail and steared over
at 10 AM saw whale board three boats
Carbone Boat struck and cut how
Boat struck and was Boat Cild
So ended Lat Byals - 33° 47'

Further Little Master

Sunday These 24 hours Commenced with brisk
at 10 breeze and fair weather all hands
Employed in whaling at 2:30 PM took
the whale to the ship at 3 PM began
cutting at 6 PM finished cutting spoke
the ship good return of New Bedford
With 4 Night whale and one Spinn
whale at 10 PM began boyling -
Middle Part fish breeze and passing
at 5 AM made sail at 8 AM big whale
at 11 AM took three boats to shore Boat
struck Carbone Boat Cild at 10:30 PM
hired to the ship and began cutting
latter Part light breeze and fair weather
So ended these 24 hours Lat Byals 33° 46'

Monday These 24 hours Commenced with light
at 10 breeze from the South and Pleasant
the 17 Weather all hands Employed on cutting
in at 2 PM finished and began boyling
at 6 PM took in sail and set the wack
at 12 Midnight were ship to the Eastward
at 5 AM made sail and steared W-SW at
9 AM saw one fin back whale latter
Part fish breeze saw ashore cutting
to the leeward - and along steering to the
Eastward So ended - Lat Byals 33° 49'

Tuesday These 24 hours Comd with Brisk breeze
at 10 from the Eastward and Cloudy weather
the 18 at one PM saw two Night whale
board three boats Bow Boat struck
Boat of them Cild one Carbone Boat
Cild one one sunk at 3 PM took
one at the ship and began cutting
at 7:30 PM finished cutting at 12 M
Midnight began boyling at 6 AM were
ship to the North at 8 AM heavy weather
at 9 AM took in the fore sail and the
