Wednesday These 24 hours Commencies with light breeze and fair weather at one P.M. at 2.5 the began cutting at 3.30 finish cutting at 4 P.M. saw whale board three boats barboat struck and killed at 9 P.M. took the whale to the ship and took in sail and let the wack Middle Part Calm at 4 A.M. began cutting at 7 A.M. finish cutting and began boiling Latter Part Calm. So Ends These 24 hours Lat By obs 33° 48

Wednesday These 24 hours Commencies with light breeze and Calm at 12 Meridians Calm at 2.5 the Boutes Carbond Boat struck and Spylond Boat killed at 5 P.M. took her to the ship at 6.30 took in sail ship head to the N.W. Middle Part Moderat at 8 A.M. wind began to blow Commence cutting at 10.30 finish cutting Latter Part Squaly No obs this day

Thursday Commencies with strong breeze and heavy weather at 2 P.M. began stowing down at 7 P.M. finish stowing and let the wack boiling Middle Part fish breeze and heavy weather at 4 A.M. heavy at 6 A.M. wind haling to the S.W. took ship to the westward Latter Part heavy weather So Ends No obs this day

Friday These 24 hours Commencies with brisk breeze and cloudy weather ship under Cloast Reef main top sail and fore sail ship head westward wack Employed in boiling saw two fin backs Middle Part fish breeze and heavy weather Latter Part Moderat attended with a heavy sea So Ends Lat By obs 33° 48

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Saturday These 24 hours Commencies with fish breeze from the Southward and squally with light showers of rain all the wack Employed on boiling at 9 A.M. let double Reef top sails at 6 P.M. took in sail and let the wack Middle Part over ship to the westward at 7 A.M. began stowing down Latter Part fin breeze and Pleasant Lat By obs 33° 52

Sunday These 24 hours Commencies with light breeze and Pleasant weather all hands Employed on boiling and stowing down at one P.M. made sail let head top sails and main topgallin sail at 6 P.M. finish stowing down at 7.30 let the wack ship head N.W. No whale in sight to day Middle Part Calm at 8 A.M. slight breeze from the N.W. at 7 A.M. Commencies stowing of the main backway at 10 A.M. finish boiling Latter Part fish breeze Lat By obs 33° 35

Monday These 24 hours Commencies with fish winds from the Northward at 3.1 the ship under all sail ship head to the westward at 4 P.M. took in the flying jib and main and Mizzen topgallin sail Middle Part strong breeze at 4 A.M. wind Enriving at 5 A.M. killed Reef the top sails at 6 A.M. took in the main sail Latter Part heavy gale Lat 34° 49
