At 5.30 Tuck in sail at 6 PM Let
the wack ship head to the North
Middle Part light breeze and Pleasant
weather at 5.40 saw whale maid sail
at 9 am bore three boats, did not strike
latter Part fish breeze Let By 6.35.00

Tuesday
At 5.30 These 24 hours Commence with
the 16 light Breeze from the S.E. and Pleasant
weather ship under all sail Hesperus all
hands Employed on Hoisting Nothing in
sight at 6 PM Tuck in sail at 11 PM
wore ship to the S.W. at 5.40 maid sail
and Stead E.S.E. at 11.40 saw whale
So Ends these 24 hours Let By 6.35.05

Wednesday
At 5.30 These 24 hours Commence with
fish breeze from the N.W. at 5.30 past
12 bore three boats at 2 PM west boat
struck one whale and the lower boat struck
another carbonic Cild at 7 PM Tuck them
to the ship and Tuck in sail at 8 PM
let the wack hoisting at 10 PM Hesperus
at 4 am began Cloting at 12 midnight
finisht Cloting So Ends these 24 hours
with light Breeze and Pleasant
weather Let By 6.35.05

Thursday
At 5.30 These 24 hours Commence with
the 17 light Breeze from the S.E. and Pleasant
weather ship head East all hands
Employed in clearing away the heads
Longue and getting ready for Hoisting at 7 PM
6.30 wore ship to the S.W. Middle Part
light Breeze at 7 am began Steering
Down at 2 am maid sail and Stead
to the N.W. saw nothing latter Part
fish Breeze and Pleasant weather
So Ends these 24 hours Let By 6.35.06

Friday
At 5.30 These 24 hours Commence with fish
Breeze from the S.W. and Cloudy ship
the 18 under all sail Hesperus all hands Employed
in Hoisting and Steering Down at 4 PM
Hesperus at 6 PM Tuck in sail at 8 PM
let the wack ship head N.E. Middle
Part light breeze at 5.40 maid sail
at 10 am saw whale bore three boats
Carbonic Boat struck lower boat Cild at
11.40 Tuck her to the ship faced to
Bee and in cut her head off and let her
go So Ends these 24 hours Let By 6.35.08

Saturday
At 5.30 These 24 hours Commence with fine
the 19 Breeze from the S.W. ship under all
sail By the wind all hands Employed
in Steering Down at 6 PM finisht
6.30.01 Steering Tuck in sail ship head S.E.
Middle Part calm at 5.40 maid sail
and Stead to the Eastward latter Part calm
Ends with light breeze Let By 6.35.03

Sunday
At 5.30 These 24 hours Commence with light
the 20 Breeze from the North and Pleasant
ship under all sail by the wind all the hands
Employed on Hoisting at 6 PM wore ship
to the Westward Tuck them the Sapsails
and let the wack Middle Part fish
Breeze and fine weather at 5.40 maid
sail and head N.W. at 12 midnight fin
isht Hoisting Let By 6.35.25

Monday
At 5.30 These 24 hours Commence with
the 21 fish Breeze from the S.W. ship under
Double Reef Sapsails ship head N.W. wind
S.W. at 6 PM Tuck in sail and let the
quarter wacker Middle Part calm at 5
40 am maid sail at 9 am saw two whale
latter Part Hesperus So Ends Let By 6.35.26
