Tuesday the 24 hours Commenced with light breeze from the S.W. and thick the 22. Ship under single Reef fore and Mizzen. Topsail at 4 P.M. saw a finback at 6.30 P.M. Tuck in the fore and Mizzen topsail and get. and pull up the main topsail and stand S.E. Middle Port light breeze at 4 A.M. wind shifted to the South in a squall Tuck in the fore sail and cloast kept the main topsail latter Part heavy Gale

Wednesday the 25 hours Commenced with heavy Gale from the South and squally weather Ship lying low under cloast kept Main topsail and fore topmast staysail at 6 P.M. Tuck in the Bow boat and turned up the mast boat at 7 A.M. kept the fore sail saw a ship to the leeward then off saw one Night whale going to the westward at 9 A.M. spoke the ship Lattin of Newport with fifteen hundred Barrels of oil latter Part moderate Latt By obs - 34.37

Thursday the 26 hours Commenced with strong Gale from the South and cloudy weather Ship under cloast Reef main topsail and fore sail all hands employed in stowing down at 9 P.M. finished at 9.30 P.M. let down Reef out the main topsail at 11 P.M. wore ship to the North at 5 A.M. made sail and stand on the wind to the Eastward at 7 A.M. began crapping down fore ships in sight at 9 A.M. saw a whale let main topsail sail main sail and flying jib to braces these 24 hours No obs this day

Friday the 24 hours Commenced with the North breeze from the S.E. and cloudy weather Ship under all sail All hands employed on crapping down at one P.M. saw a whale caught three boats harbored Boat struck the iron track at 7 P.M. Tuck in sail head to the Eastward Middle Port light breeze and started at 10.30 made sail and stand on the wind to westward at 1 P.M. saw several finbacks latter Part light breeze Latt By obs - 34.06

Saturday the 26 hours Commenced with gentle breeze from the S.E. Ship under all sail By the wind was employed on crapping down at 1 P.M. Tuck in the main topsail and flying jib and wore ship to the S.W. Middle Port calm at 4 A.M. made all sail at 9 A.M. saw several finbacks latter Part fine breeze and Pleasant Latt By obs - 34.17

Sunday the 27 hours Commenced with light breeze from the South and Pleasant weather Ship under all sail By the wind at 5 P.M. 6.13 saw sperm whale four fore boats struck East and side fore Boat Boat side fore Carboard one Starboard Boat one at 12 midnight Tuck in to the ship Tuck in sail and set back at 4.30 am began crapping down at 12 midnight finished crapping down ships in sight and one of them was neutral to the end these 24 hours Latt By obs 34.15
