

Ship Grand Turk of Dartmouth

Monday These 24 hours Commenced with
January fresh breeze from the S.E. and hazy
9th weather ship under all sail head
to the S.E. saw several sperm whale
turn flukes at 10 P.M. Tack ship to
5 P.M. 30 North westward latter Part light breeze
East and Pleasant weather Lat 13, obs 25-40

Tuesday These 24 hours Commenced with fine
10th breeze from the E.S.E. and Pleasant
weather ship under all sail work
employed on ship's duty Middle Part
light breeze and Pleasant weather at
6 am set the mizen topgallin sail
at 7 am set the flying jib latter
5 P.M. 01 Part fresh breeze and rising clouds
So ended these 24 hours Lat 13, obs 25-52

Wednesday These 24 hours Commenced with
11th the fresh breeze from the E.S.E. and
rising clouds ship under all sail
standing at work employed on ship's
duty at 7 P.M. took in the topgallin sail
flying jib took in the topgallin and
4 P.M. 30 head in North at 4:30 am made all
East sail and steared S.W. latter Part
fresh breeze and Pleasant Lat 13, obs 25-57

Thursday These 24 hours Commenced with
January fresh breeze from the E.S.E. ship under
12th all sail work employed on ship's
duty at 7 P.M. shortened sail took in the
fore and mizen topgallin and gits and
main sail and hoist up the yards
head S.W. Middle Part fresh
breeze at 4:30 am made all sail
head westward at 5 am raised the island
of Madagascar bearing west by N 25 N
latter Part strong Lat 13, obs 25-55

Friday These 24 hours Commenced with light
January breeze from the E.S.E. and Pleasant
13th ship under all sail By the wind
work employed on ship's duty at
7 P.M. took in sail ship head of S.E.
Middle Part light breeze at 4:30 am
made sail and wore ship in flow
latter Part heavy saw sperm whale
So ended these 24 hours

Saturday These 24 hours Commenced with heavy
January at one P.M. lighted up saw sperm
14th whale board the boaters carried boat
stuck and bled at 8 P.M. took the
whale to the ship and commenced
cutting at 7 P.M. finished at 6 P.M.
took in sail and set the work
boiling Middle Part fresh breeze from
the E.S.E. latter Part fresh breeze and
clear weather Lat 13, obs 25-57

Sunday These 24 hours Commenced with
15th the stronger breeze from the Eastward
ship under all sail all hands em-
ployed on boiling ship head S.W. at
6 P.M. wore ship to S.E. took in
sail Middle Part fresh breeze and
fine weather at 7 am wore ship
to the North at 10 am wore ship to
the S.E. latter Part strong breeze Lat 13, obs 25-57

Monday These 24 hours Commenced with fresh
16th breeze from the Eastward ship under
all sail took in topgallin at 8 P.M. finished
boiling at 7 P.M. hoist up the
topgallin mizen Part fresh breeze at
4:30 am began standing down
latter Part fresh breeze Lat 13, obs 25-06
