 first breeze and light Squalls at 7 AM
 49:59 on bent the fore Sail to the mast at
 East 10 AM let the Ship out the top
 to Endeavour - Lett By 20 26:20

Thursday January the 26th These 24 hours
 Commenced with fresh breeze from
 the NE and fair weather Ship under
 all sail Many were employed on ships
 duty at 6:30 PM Tackled Ship to the
 North Middle Part fresh breeze and
 Cloudy weather at one PM were Ship
 to the Eastward at 9 AM let the
 main topgallin sail Latter Part
 fresh breeze and Pleasant Lett By 20 28:00

Friday the 27th These 24 hours Commenced with
 strong breeze from the NE Ship under
 all sail By the wind were employed
 in mending sails Ship head ESE at
 4 PM Many weather Middle Part
 fresh breeze at 5 AM let the flying jib
 and main topgallin sail at 10 AM bent
 the jib and set up the head stays
 to Endeavour Lett By 20

Saturday the 28th These 24 hours Commenced with
 fresh breeze and passing Clouds Ship
 51:22 under all sail by the wind were employed
 East on ships duty Middle part fresh breeze
 and Pleasant at 4 AM wind falling
 to the Eastward at 8 AM saw ashore
 standing to the westward Lett By 20 26:15

Sunday These 24 hours Commenced with light
 January breeze from the Eastward and fair
 29 the weather Ship under all sail Steady
 30:22 were much employed on ships duty
 Middle Part fresh breeze and flying
 Clouds at 4 AM Tackled in the flying
 jib and main topgallin sail at 6 AM
 let them again Latter part fine breeze
 and Pleasant Lett By 20 26:50

Monday Jan 30 These 24 hours Commenced with fine
 breeze from the Eastward and pleasant
 Ship under all sail heading NNE
 at one PM Squared the yards and Capst
 of at 6 PM Tackled kept the Sails
 fresh in the jib and main sail and
 48:38 head ESE Middle Part light shower
 East of rain at 4 AM main sail and
 stood NNE Latter Part fresh breeze
 and pleasant Lett By 20 26:38

Tuesday January the 31st These 24 hours Commenced with
 light breeze from the ESE and passing
 Clouds Ship under all sail Many
 were employed on ships duty
 at 6 PM Tackled in sail and head to
 the Southward Middle part fresh
 breeze and Pleasant at 8 AM main
 sail at 6 AM were Ship to the North
 Latter part fine breeze Lett By 20 26:29

Wednesday Feb 1st These 24 hours Commenced with
 light breeze from the ESE and
 passing Clouds Ship under all sail by
 the wind were employed on ships duty
 at 6 PM Tackled in the flying jib and
 main topgallin sail Middle Part fine
 breeze Latter Part continued the same
 to Endeavour these 24 hours Lett By 20
