February These 24 hours Commences with the light breeze from the South and Pleasant weather Ship under all sail Steering N.W. abrup in sight to the Northward Steering in fore the land Longitude at 5 PM held up E.S.E. at 7 P.M. Tuck in 49.2 up sail Middle part Calm at 4 AM Maud all sail and Steered N.W. Latter East Part fish Breeze Latt By obs

Saturday These 24 hours Commences with the 11 fish breeze from the N.E. and fair weather Ship under all sail by the wind wack Employed on Ships Duty at 6 PM Tuck in the flying gill and Main and Mizzen Sappalinsail were ship to the E.S.E. Middle part light Breezes at 4 AM were ship to the N.W. at 9 AM saw Chole of black fish and one whale Brik to Ende Latt By obs 24.46

Sunday Feb 13 The first part of these 24 hours light breeze from the N.E. and pleasant Ship under all sail by the wind wack Employed on Ships Duty at 2 PM saw a sail to the South at 5 PM Tack to the North at 7 PM Spoke the ship Maine theme of New Bedford with fore whale Mizzen and later Part light breeze and Latt By obs 24.56

Monday Feb 14 These 24 hours Commences with the 13 light breeze from the Eastward and Pleasant weather Ship under all Longitude sail by the wind to the S.E. at 6 PM Tack to the North at 12 midnight East Tack to the S.E. at 6 AM saw sperm whale could not get fast because there put one Latt Part Mordenat Latt By obs 25.03

Ship Grand Fork 1837

Tuesday Feb 14 The first part of these 24 hours Commences with light breezes from the Eastward and Pleasant weather Ship under all sail by the wind wack Employed on Ships Duty and Ship in sight astern at 6 PM Tack to the South Middle Part fish breeze at 8 AM were ship to the North and have the main yard aback at 6 AM Turn of N.W. at 8 AM held up N.W. Latter Part fish Breeze and fair weather Latt By obs 25.17

Wednesday Feb 15 These 24 hours Commences with light breezes from the E.S.E. and squally at Ende with light showers of rain at 3 PM Tuck in the flying gill one sail 49.46 in sight at 6 PM Tack ship to the East S.E. at 12. Midnight Tack ship to the N.E. at 7 AM saw ashore standing to the westward Latter Part light breeze and Pleasant Latt By obs 25.49

Thursday Feb 16 These 24 hours Commences with the light breezes from the Eastward and Pleasant weather Ship under all sail by the wind wack Employed on Ships Duty at 1 PM Tuck in the flying gill and Mizzen Sappalinsail at 7 PM Tuck in the fore and Mizzen Sappalins and Tack the main Sappalins at 4 AM Maud all sail Latter Part squally Latt By obs 25.50

Friday Feb 17 These 24 hours Commences with fish breeze from the S.E. and breezy weather Ship under all sail by the wind wack Employed on Ships Duty Middle Part light breeze at 4 AM Maud sail Latter Part Calm Latt By obs 26.42
