

Continued March 1837

Sunday These 24 hours Commenced with
March fish breezes and fair weather. Still
the 6 lying in St August town bay. Hunting
Middle Port Lying Lateral Port fish
breeze so ended these 24 hours

Monday These 24 hours Commenced with
March with breezes from the E & E and fair
the 6 Weather ship lying in August st bay
Hunting Middle Port hot and
Lateral Port fish so ends

Tuesday the first part covered with light breeze
March and March still lying in August town
the 7 Bay Hunting went up the river just
got one Whellock Creek it at 4 PM came
on Board one work on shore on Liberty
Lateral Port ended with fish breeze

Wednesday These 24 hours Commenced with fair
March breezes from the E & E and clear
the 6 Weather ship still lying in August town
Bay Hunting two Boats towing water
from the ship Atlantic of Warren
Lateral Port ended with light breeze

Thursday These 24 hours Commenced with
March light breezes from the E & E sent
the 9 Master left on shore after a whole
all hands employed in getting ship
ready for sea at 8 am Boat born on
Board took in the whole wind did
sea breeze set in Middle Port Port
Clear weather Lateral Port continued
the same so ended these 24 hours
A Count Ships Atlantic main
Breeze again Breeze gone and March
Ship still on main

Friday These 24 hours Commenced with
the 10 fish breezes from the S & W and
fair weather still lying in August
town bay Middle Port calm Lateral Port
ended the same so ended these 24 hours

Saturday
the 11 These 24 hours Commenced with light
breezes from the S & W at 4 PM put
under way and went to sea at 6 PM
saw ashore going in all hands employed
in stowing the anchors so ended these
24 hours with 12 hours harbor about

Sunday
the 12 These 24 hours Commenced with light
breezes from the S & W ship under all
sail crew employed on ship duty
Middle Port light breezes Lateral
Port ended with calm and hot
weather Lateral Port 24 hrs

Monday
the 13 These 24 hours Commenced with light
breezes from the S & W and fair weather
ship under all sail by the wind
Middle Port calm at 4 PM on board
the fore topsail to spare Lateral port
calm Lateral Port 24 hrs

Tuesday
the 14 These 24 hours Commenced with
calm work employed on minding
the fore topsail at 4 PM sent the
fore topsail Middle Port calm
Lateral Port continued the same
Lateral Port 24 hrs

Wednesday
March These 24 hours Commenced with light breeze
the 15 and March ship under all sail
work employed on ship duty Middle
Port light breezes Lateral Port
continued the same Lateral Port 24 hrs
