Wednesday These 24 hours Commence with
May Strong gale from the SE and Squall
the 3 Ship going tow under Mizzen stay sail
and fore topmast stay sail at 2 PM
more moderate at 10 PM let the Coast
Hut main topmast at 5 AM let the
4 7 40 Coast Hut fore topmast and fore sail
Latter Part main all sail Let By 3 50

Thursday These 24 hours Commence with light
May the 4 Breeze from the SE ship head SE by E
Middle Part Calm at one AM light
Breeze from the SE at 3 AM strong
Breeze and Squall Latter Part continue
in the same as the day

Friday These 24 hours Commence with light
May the 5 Breeze from the SE and cloudy
weather Ship under all sail crew em-
ployed on ships duty Middle Part Calm
at 5 AM light breeze from the South
at 6 AM on board the main topmast
sail to topmast Latter Part Calm to end
These 24 hours Let By 3 51

Saturday These 24 hours Commence with light
May the 6 breeze and Calm ship under all sail
wreck employed on ships duty at one
PM Breeze the topmast sail at 5 PM
slight breeze Middle Part strong breeze
from the SE and cloudy Latter Part
Ends the same Let By 3 52

Sunday These 24 hours Commence with strong
May the 7 Breeze from the SE and cloudy weather
Ship under all sail wreck employed
on ships duty Middle Part fair breeze
Latter Part light breeze and variable
to end no obs there any

Monday These 24 hours Commence with light
May the 8 Breeze and flustering ship under all sail
By the wind at 1 PM by wind
Middle Part Calm at 2 AM slight breeze
6 4 27 from the ESE Latter part continued
the same Let By 3 53

Tuesday These 24 hours Commence with light
May the 9 Breeze from the SE ship under all sail
wreck employed on ships duty Middle
Part fresh breeze from the ESE at
6 6 11 5 also moderate Latter Part continued
the same Let By 3 54

Wednesday These 24 hours Commence with fresh
May the 10 breeze from the ESE and thick weather
Ship under all sail head SE by E
employed on ships duty at 5 PM went
hole PM Middle Part fresh breeze and
cloudy weather Latter Part wind in
6 9 30 existing fresh breeze the topmast to end
no obs there any

Thursday These 24 hours Commence with fresh
May the 11 gale and cloudy weather Ship under
single reef topmast staying SE by E
at 6 PM wind existing Coast Hut the
fore topmast at 7 AM let the main sail
7 2 30 jib let one reef out the topmast Latter
Part moderate Let By 3 55

Friday These 24 hours Commence with light
May the 12 Breeze from the westward and variable
Ship under all sail Middle Part -
Calm at 6 AM heavy Squall from the
SE took in the fore and main topmast
7 4 23 Latter Part moderate main sail
to end Let By 3 56
