tiller kept the topsails tuck in the
gib and main sail at 7 AM Comm.
Boiling latter Part strong Breeze
from the WSW so ends

Thursday These 24 hours Commences with
Sun. Strong winds from the WSW with
the 1 heavy sea the wack employed
on Boiling at 6 PM tuck in
the fore and Mizzen topsails cleave
kept the main topsail out. Turned
out the Key latter Part strong
gale from the west tuck in the
fore and Mizzen topsails
so ends these 24 hours
