Thursday These 24 hours Begun with strong
Sun from North to NW and Squally
the 16 Tuck in fore sail turned up the
Larboard Boat Middle Part Strong
gale at 7 AM set the fore sail
Kept heading NW and NW NW
to Endeavour These 24 hours

Friday These 24 hours Begun with strong
Sun the 16 gales from the NW steering NW
the land at the weather Bore at 5
set fore and Mizzen Topsail and fore
Topsail clearest Kept moderate more
at 6 AM set all sail at 7 AM bore
3 Boats and went in shore 20 miles
Distance light winds from the west

Saturday These 24 hours Begun with light
Sun the 17 winds 3 Boats in shore struck a whale
to the Larboard Boat turned her up
Put in awast and left her on board
at 6 PM Middle Part fish breeze
and Squally Bore up to windward
But did not see the whale at 9 PM
Boats went in shore saw plenty of
whale to windward came of long line
at noon clearest Kept the Topsails

Sunday These 24 hours Begun with strong
Sun the 18 gale from the North steering NW
at 4 PM Tuck in the fore and Mizzen
Topsail at 5 PM Kept the fore sail
on Bent the clearest Mizzen to mend

Middle Part Strong gale
Latter Part continued the same
and heavy

Monday These 24 hours Begun with strong
Sun wind from the North and heavy at 4
the 19 PM wore ship to the ESE set
the fore and Mizzen Topsail turned awast
out the main Topsail Middle Part
main all sail wind at 10 AM at 4 AM
strong breeze and heavy Tuck in fore
and Mizzen Topsail and clearest Mizzen
the main Topsail at 6 set clearest
Kept Topsails at 10 3 Boats in shore

Tuesday These 24 hours Begun with fish
Sun the 20 breeze from NW 3 Boats in shore
struck a whale to the west Boat and
Tuck her Middle Part fish gale
from NW and plenty of Tuck clearest
Kept the Topsails at 11 the wind
shifted to the NW Latter Part
strong breeze from the SW the wack
employed in mending the Mizzen
turned awast the fore and Mizzen
Topsails and set the main sail

Wednesday These 24 hours Begun with strong
Sun the 21 winds from SW Middle Part
Squally at 6 AM 3 Boats went in
shore saw several whale the land
15 miles Distance Latter Part light
breeze and sun heavy

Thursday These 24 hours Begun with light
Sun the 22 winds from SW 3 Boats in shore
saw several whale But could not
strike Middle Part light winds from
SW at 7 AM Past 6 AM bore 3 Boats
and went in shore saw a cow and
calf struck the calf to the Larboard
Boat and the cow to the Bow Boat
Tuck her to the ship kept on at 10 AM
