

Amsterdam Island 1837

Saturday These 24 hours began with light
Sun winds from the NW. At 11 AM
the 23 kept the topsails all hands
Employed at boiling claring up
decks and fitting the boats. Middle
Part Strong gale. Tuck in fore and
mizzen topsail. Closest kept the
main topsail. Cold down the works
at 4 AM. Set Dull kept topsails
at 10 AM. Closest the main topsails
and kept the fore sail. Latter Part

Sunday These 24 hours began with a gale
the 24 of wind from SW at 1 PM. Burned
the tuck out the fore sail at 6. Set
Closest kept topsails. Middle Part
Commenced boiling at 7 AM. Strong
gale from west and squalls of rain
cold down the works. Latter Part
the same 6 ships in sight.

Sunday These 24 hours began with strong
the 25 gale from the W-SW steering to
the South at 5 PM. were ship
to the NW. Middle Part. Main
sail at 7 commenced boiling at 9. 3
Boats went in shore. Struck awl and
burned her up to the west Boat
No ship in sight.

Monday These 24 hours began with moderate
the 26 breeze from the west. got the whale
longside and heaved on gut her in
at 5.6 reloaded away the head and began
Boiling and ship in sight. Middle
Part Strong Breeze. Latter Part Strong
gale from the north. Tuck the fore
and mizzen topsails 6 ships in sight.

Tuesday These hours began with strong gale
Sun from the NW. all hands emp.
the 27 land at boiling at 4 PM. cold down
the works at 6. Kept the fore sail
and burned up the west Boat
middle and latter Part heavy gal at
5 ships in sight. Burned the tuck out
the fore sail.

Wednesday These 24 hours began with strong
Sun gale from the NW at 1 PM. were
the 28 ship to the NW. St. Peter and am-
sterdam in sight at 2. Commenced
boiling at 6. cold down the works.
Kept the fore sail and were ship to
the W-SW. Middle Part Strong wind
at 7. Burned the tuck out the fore sail
and commenced boiling and stowing
oil aft.

Thursday These 24 hours began with strong
Sun breeze from the NW and NW. the
the 29 more ship to the NW. all hands
Employed at boiling at 4 PM. Set
fore and mizzen topsails. Closest kept
middle Part. Dull kept topsails.
Strong North wind SW at 4. 3 Boats
land and went in shore. Struck
awl and to the west Boat the line gut
cut. Struck one to the Bow Boat and
got store.

Friday These 24 hours began with fresh
Sun winds from the South and Sun
the 30. Dull 2 Boats in shore. Middle part
light winds at 6. 3 Boats went in
shore. Struck awl and to the west
Boat and tuck her to the ship at
6.40 light winds from the South.
