

Ship Grand Turk 1837

Monday These 24 hours began with strong
July breeze from the W & W steering by
17th the at 1 PM we were ship to the
South set about Reef Topsails
and Reef the fore sail at 8
hook in the fore sail middle
Part strong gale turned up the
Boats at 2 PM hook in the main
Topsail latter Part heavy gal
Shiped a sea and stave the mast
Boat on the Cannons

Tuesday These 24 hours began with a heavy
July breeze from the W & W heading
to the South under fore Topmast
and Mizzen staysail and about Mizzen
at 2 am movement were ship to
the N & E and set about Reef Top
sails latter Part the work employed
in mending the new main Top
sail repairing the Bow Boat

Wednesday These 24 hours began with fine
July breeze from the west heading to
19th the N & W under about Reef Top
sails at 12 we were ship to the S & W
latter Part set double Reef Topsails
and main sails were ship arriving
to the N & W

Thursday These 24 hours began with fine
July breeze from the W & W steering
20th the breeze from the W & W steering
by the wind to the N & W under
double Reef Topsails at 6 turned
out the Reefs at one am packed
ship to the S & W latter Part
single Reef the Topsails heading
W & W

Monday These 24 hours began with strong
July breeze from the N & W steering by
21st the wind was W under single Reef
Topsails at 4 PM hook in the main
sail and side middle Part fish
barges latter Part about Reef the
Topsails steering west

Tuesday These 24 hours began with strong
July breeze from the N & W steering west
22nd the wind from the N & W steering west
under about Reef Topsails at 5
hook the fore sail middle Part
strong wind at 10 am hook in the
fore and Mizzen Topsail wind
shifted to west & W and heavy

Wednesday These 24 hours began with strong
July breeze from the W & W at 1 PM
23rd the were ship to the North set fore and
Mizzen Topsails turned the Reef out
off the fore sail middle Part
more movement at 6 am light
winded made all sail one ship in
light latter Part strong breeze
from the N & W steering N & W

Monday These 24 hours began with strong
July breeze from the N & E and heavy
24th the steering N & W kept the Topsails and
hook in the main sail and side
at 5 PM wind shifted to the N & W
at 6 about Reef the Topsails hook
in the fore sail middle Part
heavily with thunder and lightning
at 8 made all sail steering N & W
wind N & W at 10 about Reef the
Topsails latter Part strong breeze
