August These 24 hours Begins with fresh
31st Breeze middle Part much the same
latter Part light breeze brought off
from the shore 4 Cages of Tea and
5 Cans of Beef

Friday
Sept These 24 hours Begins with light
the 1st winds middle and latter Part much
the same brought off 2500 Pounds
of Bread So Ends

Saturday
Sept These 24 hours Begins with light
the 2nd winds and Pleasant weather and
Ends the same

Sunday
Sept These 24 hours Begins with light
the 3rd winds and Pleasant weather and
Continued the same

Monday
Sept These 24 hours Begins with fine
the 4th weather Latter Part got a raft of
water of So Ends

at Port Louis, Isle of France

Tuesday These 24 hours Begins with fine
Sept weather all hands Employed on
the stowing some weather Latter Part
fine weather

Wednesday
Sept These 24 hours Begins with light
the 6th winds middle and latter Part the
same brought off some Vegetables
got the one anchor on the Board and
lashed it at 10 AM the Boat went
on shore and Antonio Silva aboard

Thursday

could not find Antonio Silva nor up
the anchor and stood out stowing west
Latter Part in Company with the
20th 45th Hornon middle Part stowing by the
wind SW latter Part the same
lashed the anchors and stood the Chum
the low at 9 AM the land Bore EWS
Dist 30 miles

Board the Hornon saw humpback whales
