Oct the 3 gale from the S.W. ship lying
Now under least full main Tapsails
and fore sail wack employed on
Long Boyling at 3 P.M. finish Boyling at
6 P.M. more ship to the North and in
5 P.M. 30 the fore sail Middle Part light breeze
East and Pleasant at 5:30 A.M. made sail
and began working out the fore hold
at 7 A.M. Began showing down oil in
the fore hold Latter Port light Breeze
Latt By 6 35 27 South

Oct the 4 Breeze from the North at 4 P.M. finish
showing down at 6:30 P.M. Tuck
in sail and set the wack Main Middle

Oct the 5 heavy gale from the S.W. and
thick weather ship heading S.E. under
least full main Tapsails and fore sail
Long at 6 P.M. Tuck in the fore sail and
5 P.M. 30 fore fore head North Middle Part heavy
