Monday These 24 hours Begins with heavy
out-gale from the S.W. ship lying
the 13 Saw under cleast Reef main Sapsail
and fore sail and Mizzen at 5 PM
wore ship to the N.E. and cleast
Reef the main Sapsail over again and
set the work middle Part fish Boze
at 5 AM main sail set cleast Reef
Sapsails at 9 AM took in the fore and
Mizzen Sapsails at 11 took in the fore sail
Latter Part heavy gale from the S.W.

Saturday These 24 hours Begins with heavy gale
out the 14 from the S.W. ship lying too under
cleast Reef main Sapsail Mizzen and fore
Sapsails Stunsail head S.W. & middle
Part heavy gale at 5 AM set the
fore sail Latter Part heavy weather
So ends Latter By obs 34.06 South

Sunday These 24 hours Begins with heavy
out the 15 gale from the W.S. and Squally
ship lying too under cleast Reef
main Sapsail and fore sail for Saps
muzzel sail and Mizzen head S.W. &
middle Part Strong Boze at 4.30 AM
Latter Part saw two ships Latter Part
the 10 Light winds and fine weather Latter By obs

Monday These 24 hours Begins with light winds
out the 16 from the S.W. ship under all sail By
wind 5. Sail in sight at 11 PM saw
two wright whale bound for Boat was
Boat struck and died at 2.30 PM took
her to the ship and took in sail and
set the work middle Part light Boze
at 5 AM began cutting the whale at
9 AM finished 6 ships in sight
Latter By obs 34.01 South

off Dartmouth 1837

Monday These 24 hours Begins with brisk
out breeze from the S.E. and fine weather
the 17 ship under all sail By the wind
all hands Employed and Hoisting
at 6.30 PM took in sail head S.W.
at 12 midnight wore ship to the N.E.
at 5 AM main sail at 6 AM saw one
Right whale going fast to the Eastward
Latter Part fish winds Latter By obs 33.33

Tuesday These 24 hours Begins with fish
out the 18 Windes from the E.S. ship under
Reef Sapsails all hands Employed
Hoisting at 6 PM spoke the ship
Commander of New London for month
out at 7 PM set the ship head South
at 12 midnight wore ship to the N.E.
at 5 AM finished Hoisting at 6.30 AM
began stowing down ship heading S.W. &
Latter Part Strong gale from the E.S. &
So ends these 24 hours By obs this day

Wednesday These 24 hours Begins with strong gale
out the 19 from the E.S. and heavy weather ship
lying too under cleast Reef main Sapsail
head S.W. & at 5 PM finished stowing down
at 6 PM set the work middle Part
Strong gale at 8 AM took in the fore
Boat turned up the work Boat Latter
Part Heavy weather. So obs this day

Thursday These 24 hours Begins with strong winds
out the 20 and heavy at one PM set double Reef
Sapsails at 4 PM got out the fore Boat
one ship in sight a strong ship head
East wind N.E. & at 6.30 PM took in
Latter Part middle Part fish Boze at 5 AM
main sail at 9 saw whale bound Boats Boat
Boat struck at 10 AM got her to the ship
