Saturday These 24 hours Begins with strong gale
at 6th from the ESE and began with ship with
the whale but could not cut her at
4 PM were back again middle part the
same at 4.30 PM were ship and began
cutting at 4 PM finished cutting latter
part spruce the ship cleared of all down
with 5 whale latter by 4.30

Sunday These 24 hours Begins with strong breeze
at 6th from the South cloudy weather ship
under Oble Day topsails heading ESE
all hands employed on hauling 4 ships
in sight at 6.30 PM duck in sail and
set the wack middle part light breeze
at 4.30 AM maid all sail head ESE at
8 AM saw whale board and struck in
latter boat one and wack boat one at
12 Meridian duck them to the ship
to cross the 24 Lat By obs 34.21

Monday These 24 hours Begins with strong
at 6th breeze from the NW at one PM be
gan cutting at 5 PM finished cutting
one the other sunk so deep concluded to
let her lay till morning middle part
fish from the NW and many at 5 AM
began cutting the whale at 6 AM finished
cutting mail sail and began hauling
latter part fine weather Lat By obs

Tuesday These 24 hours Begins with light breeze
at 6th from the west ship head SSW at 6 PM
duck in sail and set the wack middle
part light breeze at 10 AM maid all
sail and head of ESE at 4 PM began
stowing down one ship in sight to
the South latter part fish breeze
from the NW

Ship, Grand Turk 1837

Wednesday These 24 hours Begins with fish
at 6th breeze from the NW and cloudy
the 26 weather ship under all sail all hands
employed on hauling and stowing down
at 5 PM finished stowing down at 5.30
PM saw whale board did not strike
Longitude at 6.30 PM duck in sail ship head NW
at 6.30 AM middle part fish breeze at 5 AM maid
sail at 7 AM began stowing down at 12
Meridian finished Lat By obs 34.38

Thursday These 24 hours Begins with fish breeze
at 6th from the NW ship head ESE all
hands employed on hauling at 5 PM
many at 6 PM duck in sail head NW
middle part light breeze at 3 PM were
ship to the NW at 4.30 AM maid all sail
head ESE latter part fish winders and
cloudy weather to cross Lat By obs 34.48

Friday These 24 hours Begins with fish
at 6th breeze from the NW ship head ESE
all the wack employed on hauling
at 5 PM saw whale to the NW
at 6.30 PM duck in sail head NW
at 12 midnight were ship to the NW
at 3 AM finished hauling at 5 AM
first gale from the NW at 7 AM
began stowing down at 8 AM spruce
the barken Emerald of Salem with 12
at 12 Meridian finished stowing Lat 34.54

Saturday These 24 hours Begins with heavy gale
at 6th from the west ship lying under close
the 26 reef main topsail and fore sail head
ing North middle part fish gale at 7 AM
duck in the fore sail and were ship to
the SSE latter part strong gale
Lat By obs 35.45
