Monday These 24 hours begins with
 light breeze from the NW ship
 under all sail by the wind at one
 the 6 PM board three Boats for one wright
 whole and Chast but of course
 at 6:30 PM Tuck in sail and head to
 the westward Middle Part fresh breeze
 at 4 AM made sail and stand SE at
 East 7 AM saw one Right whale board 3
 Boats and Chast did not get fast
 at 9 AM on board the fore sail to men
 latter Part his breeze latter By obs 3.3.3.3

Tuesday These 24 hours begins with strong
 the 7 breezes from the NW and the
 weather at one PM bent the fore
 sail at 6 PM Tuck in sail and
 head to the NE & Middle Part
 fresh breeze and cloudy weather at 4
 AM made all sail and stand up two
 the 10 wind to the SE at 7 AM saw five back
 latter Part light winds and fine
 weather so ended latter By obs 3.3.3.3

Wednesday These 24 hours commences with
 the 8 light winds from the NW and fine
 weather ship under all sail by the
 wind at 6 PM were ship to the NW
 under all sail set two watches Middle
 Part fresh breeze and thick weather ship
 the 15 heading NW latter Part wind at the
 SE latter By Estimation 3.3.3.3

Thursday These 24 hours begins with light
 the 16 breeze from the SE at 5 AM saw
 whole board the Boats three Boats
 got fast the barbed Boats to the South
 the Bow Boat struck and died at 7
 PM Tuck the whole to the at 4 PM began
 cutting at 9 AM finished latter Part the 16

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Friday These 24 hours begins with light
 the 17 breezes from the North and thick fog
 by weather ship head NW at 3 PM
 saw ashore to the westward at 4 PM
 foggy at 6 PM Tuck in sail and were
 ship to the NE and began fogging
 at 8 PM heavy cold fog at 10 Midnight
 Longitudinal ship to the South at 4 AM set
 the 18 closest Reef Sapsales and began fogging
 East latter Part foggy at 11 AM Tuck out
 of back Sapsales latter By obs 3.3.3.3 South

Saturday These 24 hours begins with strong
 the 19 breeze from the NW were ship to
 the South at 6 PM were ship to the
 NW at 7 PM closest light the Sapsales
 and set the watch saw one Right whale
 Middle Part fine weather at 4 AM
 were ship to the SE at 6 AM saw whole
 board three Boats barbed boat struck
 and died latter Part fresh breeze and
 cloudy latter By obs 3.3.3.3

Sunday These 24 hours begins with strong
 the 20 breeze from the west at 4 PM finished
 the 21 fogging at 6 PM saw whole board three
 Boats barbed Boat struck and died
 Bow Boat struck and died the watch
 Boat struck another whole died and saw
 at 6:30 PM came on Board Tuck in
 sail and set the watch at 12 Midnight
 were ship at 4:30 AM made sail and
 head to the NW at 6 AM began storming down
 Between decks latter Part fresh breeze
 from the NW and misty weather
 saw several whole going to the westward
