Sunday These 24 hours we began with
several fish gales from the west and
the 17 Nanny weathered ship lying two miles
east of the main topsails and fore sail
heading to the SW at 6 PM we ship
to the SW & Middle Part fish breeze
at 5 AM thick misty weather at 6
AM set double reef topsails and
main sail we ship to the south
Latter Part fish breeze saw two light
whale going to the westward Lat 33.53

Monday

These 24 hours began with fish
breeze from the west and thick weather
ship under double reef topsails at
one PM we ship to the SW middle
Part fish gales at 3 AM duck in the
fore sail at 10 AM sail away ship
East steering ESE latter Part strong gales
from the west at 12 middle were
ship to the south Lat 33.17

Tuesday

These 24 hours began with heavy
thick gales from the SW ship heading south
from under close reef main topsail and
mizen stay sail at 5 PM we ship to
East the SW SW at 6 PM set the fore
sail and mizen middle Part breeze
Moderate at 4 AM main sail set double
reef topsails at 7 AM set the gill and
main sail all hands employed on
craping boom Lat 33.11

Wednesday

These 24 hours began with fish
gales from the SW ship under double
reef topsails heading to the SW SW
all hands employed on craping boom at
3 PM saw one whale at 5 PM duck in
sail head to the SW

Thursday These 24 hours began with light wind
Adm and Vebble attended with light steam off
the 23 Saw at one PM saw ashore to the west
under small sail at 4.30 PM saw two whales
Main sail leave three boats and chest
But did not get fast at 6.30 PM duck
in sail head to the SW the ship shrou
in sight middle Part light breeze and
thick weather at 4.30 AM main sail
East and stand on the wind at 12 latter Part
light breeze and Vebble Lat 33.44

Friday

These 24 hours began with light wind
the 24 from the SW ship under all sail
By the wind to the SW all the week
Employed on Ships Duty at 4 PM duck
East in sail head to the westward middle Part
light breeze at 4 AM main all sail and
stand to the westward at 6 AM saw two
light whale board three boats and
chest did not stick at 11 AM saw a
ship to the westward Lat 33.48

Saturday

These 24 hours began with light
breeze from the North ship under all
sail at one PM spoke the ship Asia
of Harar de graft with 150 barrels of oil
Capt Little went on board at 5 PM return
to Harar de graft at 6.30 PM double reef
the topsails and stood west middle Part
light breeze and thick weather at 4 AM
thick and misty at 6 AM lifted up set
Main sail and gill at 8 AM set the
Vebble out the topsails and set the
and set the main topsails sail at
9 AM duck in the main topsails
sail spoke the ship America quar of
Harar de graft 500 barrels off oil
Lat 33.44
