Sunday These 24 hours begins with first
Saw the 26 single Reef Topsails. Strong west weather
in sight at 2 P.M. saw one fine back
long whale. Middle Part. Fish gales at 5 A.M.
Doubt. Next the Topsails at 10 A.M.
East. Took in the main sail and got and
lost the fore and mizen Topsails.
Latter Part fish gales and heavy
weather. So ends this day.

Monday
Saw these 24 hours begins with fish breeze
the 27 from the west at one P.M. were ship
to the north at 2 P.M. let the mizen out
the fore Topsail let go and main sail
from let out the mizen Topsail mid
dle Part. Breeze at 2 A.M. set the main
East. Topsail at 4 A.M. let the tops out
the fore and mizen Topsail at 6 A.M. saw
no whale going fast to the windward one
ship in sight at 8 A.M. saw ahead what
at 10 A.M. took him to the ship at 11 A.M.
Began cutting latter Part. Calm and clear
about weather. Lat By obs 34.03

Tuesday
Saw these 24 hours begins with light air
the 28 from the NW all hands employed on
cutting at 3 P.M. finished at 5 P.M. began
Boiling ship head SW at 9 P.M. spoke
the ship Amaranth of New Bedford Capt
gifford with 2700 barrels of oil. Mizen
Part fine breeze at 4 P.M. were ship to the
north at 7 A.M. single Reef the Topsails
the ship Amaranth still in sight at 10
A.M. wind evening ship head. 8 P.M.
let the mizen stay sail all
hands employed on Boiling
latter Part ends the day
Lat By obs 34.05

Wednesday These 24 hours begins with fish
Saw gales from the NW. No wind. Fair weather
the 29 ship under single Reef Topsails all
hands employed on Boiling ship head
NW at 6 P.M. let the main. Topsail
sail ship head SW at 12 midnight finish
Boiling at 4 A.M. saw whale at 6 A.M. load
three boats went Boat struck barrel boat
struck the shore whale and died at 12
Mizen the whale moved up and sunk
So ends these 24 hours Lat By obs 34.33

Thursday
Saw these 24 hours begins with fish breeze
the 30 from the SW ship under all sails. By
the wind heading was in all hands
employed on Boiling down at 4 P.M.
7 P.M. finish Boiling Middle Part light
breeze and pleasant at 6 A.M. were hol-
ing to the west ship head North at 7 A.M.
were ship to the SW one sail in sight
latter Part light breeze and pleasant
Weather. So ends Lat By obs 34.45

Friday
Saw these 24 hours commences with
light breeze and fair weather ship
under all sail by the wind was
employed on ship's duty at 2 P.M. were
holing to the SW Middle Part light
breeze at one A.M. were began to fish
latter Part fish breeze. Lat By obs 34.46

Saturday
Saw these 24 hours begins with fish
the 31 Windless from the NW ship under
all sail head Westward employed on
storing up. Middle Part light
breeze and heavy weather ship heading
to the Westward under all sail.
latter Part strong wind heavy weather
Lat By obs 34.50
