

Continued 1837

Sunday These 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from the North and hazy weather. Ship under all sail heading N. by E. at 2 P.M. saw a sail ahead at 4 P.M. such in the main. Sargolast sail at 5 P.M. saw again off what board 2 Boats. To which did not strike at 7 P.M. spoke the Ship Chimera of New Bedford with 100 of sail at 7.30 P.M. such in sail. Middle Port light breeze at 4 P.M. main sail. Steer. S. E. one sail in sight. Latter Part Drisly. 8 obs this day.

Monday These 24 hours begins with light breeze and calm at noon. Saw 2 Whales. One three Boats and Chart Boat did not strike at 7 P.M. such in sail. Middle Port light breeze and hazy weather at 4 P.M. main sail headed N. E. at 9 A.M. saw whale. It came in thick haze about latter Part. Thick foggy at 12 Meridian. Saw one whale.

Tuesday These 24 hours begins with light breeze and thick weather at noon. Saw whale. Board two Boats. Carboard Boat struck and Cild at 2 P.M. such the whale to the ship and began cutting at 6.30 finish cutting such in sail and let the wack to clear away the head at 12 midnight were ship to the S. E. at 3 A.M. were ship to the Westward and began heaving at 4 A.M. Main sail & ships in sight at 6 A.M. were ship to the S. E. saw whale gain fast to the westward at 10 A.M. saw whale. One & Boats. West Boat struck and ahead. Latter Part light breeze. Lat. 34° 34' South.

Wednesday These 24 hours begins with light breeze and fair weather. Ship under all sail by the wind to the westward. Whale in sight at 8 P.M. board 2 boats. Carboard Boat struck and Cild at 2 P.M. such the whale to the ship at 3 P.M. began cutting at 6.30 P.M. finish at 7 P.M. such in sail. head to S. W. by W. Middle Port light breeze at 4 P.M. main head to the S. E. & sail in sight. Latter Part. Calm at 12 Meridian. Spoke the Ship Marcia of Gardiner with 2000 Lat. 34° 34' South.

Thursday These 24 hours begins with light breeze from the S. W. ship under all sail by the wind all hours. Employed all heaving and lying up. Sailed at 7 P.M. such in sail. Head S. W. Middle Port Calm at 2 A.M. light breeze from the S. W. at 4 A.M. main sail at 6 P.M. saw whale. One the boats. Carboard Boat struck at 11 A.M. board. Latter Part fresh breeze.

Friday These 24 hours begins with fresh breeze from the S. W. ship under all sail by the wind at 2 P.M. saw whale. Board three Boats. West Boat struck and Cild. Sound out the line. Bow Boat struck whale. Sound out the line. Carboard Boat kept up the west boats line. Bow Boat lost her line at 7 P.M. such in sail and let the wack fore sail in sight. Middle Port fine weather at 9 A.M. saw whale. Board the Boats. West Boat struck. Bow Boat Cild such to the ship at noon. Even. calm.
