Saturday These 24 hours begins with
 Secum light breeze from the S.W. ship
 the 16 under all sail by the wind all
 the work employed at stowing off
 the fore hand Middle Part light
 breeze from the South at 3 AM
 Stead W.S. at 4 AM began craping
 Boon latter Part light breeze from
 the S.E. Latt By obs 3.5. 38

Sunday These 24 hours begins with breeze
 the 17 from the S.E. and fair weather
 ship under all sail work employed
 at craping Boon at one PM saw sail
 to the S.W. and steering to the North
 at 2.30 PM saw ship to the westward
 steering on the wind to the Southward
 at 5 PM saw the ship sailing
 Middle Part light breeze at 5 AM
 saw whale lobs and struck one to
 the bow Boat and drew struck
 one to the waist Boat and she took
 the line and went off came on Board
 at 8 saw again of whale struck on
 to the bow Boat and drew her to
 the ship at 10 put down and hooked on
 at 11 one ship in sight and one
 Barge and plenty off whale

Monday These 24 hours begins with light
 the 18 breeze from the S.W. all hands
 employed at cutting gut the whale
 saw at 2 PM at 4 saw whale struck
 to the waist Boat she drew struck to
 the Bow Boat and cide at 6 PM took
 her to the ship hooked on and cut her
 in Middle Part fish Boon begin with
 main Sapsail at 8 AM were ship to S.E.
 latter Part fish Boon Latt 3.5. 33 5

Tuesday These 24 hours begins with fish
 Secum breeze from the S.W. heading
 the 19 to the S.W. under about 1/2 main
 Sapsail work employed at boiling
 at 4.30 PM set the forward Mizen
 Sapsail at 5.30 PM bore the Boat
 fore whale struck to the Bow Boat
 and took her long side at 7 PM took
 sail and set the work latter Part
 fish Boon all hands employed
 at boiling and setting up sheets at 10
 AM were ship and hooked on to the
 whale and cut her in toeward under
 fish Boon and high sea 10 AM the day

Wednesday These 24 hours begins with strong
 the 20 breeze all hands employed on cutting
 in the whale wind to S.W. heading to
 the S.W. Middle Part fish Boon at
 6 AM were ship to the S.E. latter
 Part all hands employing boiling
 stowing oil between decks foreward
 so enter there 24 hours 10 AM

Thursday These 24 hours begins with fish
 the 21 breeze from the S.W. heading to the
 S.E. with a high swell all hands
 employed at boiling and stowing oil
 at 5 PM were ship to the S.W.
 Middle Part fish breeze at 10.30
 were ship to the S.E. at 5 AM main sail
 head to the South latter Part light breeze
 Latt By obs 3.5. 12

Friday These 24 hours begins with light breeze
 the 22 from the west ship under three Sapsails
 all hands employed at boiling and stow-
 ing down at 7 PM took her to the S.W.
 set single Mizen Sapsail head to the S.W.
 latter Part fish Boon Latt By obs
