Saturday These 24 hours begins with
 a gentle breeze from the S.W. ship
 the 26 heading west all hands employed
 at Hoisting and Coasting at 7 P.M. such
 in sail for the night as 9 P.M. fine
 light Hoisting set of the masts and
 Coasting about middle part light breeze
 at 4.30 P.M. made sail at 6 A.M. Hoisting
 at 9 A.M. began stowing oil in Blower
 Room latter part fine weather 30.45

Sunday These 24 hours begins with light
 the 26 breeze from the S.W. ship under
 had three topsails heading to the W. 3/4
 all hands employed at stowing off
 in the blower Room at 4 P.M. finished
 at 5 P.M. set the main topsail
 sail came W. 3/4 middle part light
 breeze at 6 A.M. thick weather
 latter part fine breeze latter by obs 30.45

Monday These 24 hours begins with
 the 26 breeze from the S.W. and thick
 weather ship under all sail by the
 6.30 heading west homeward bound with
 26.00 barrels off oil at 5 P.M. wore ship
 to the North at 7 P.M. Stead S.W. 3/4
 middle part fine breeze at 6 A.M. began
 Coasting Room latter part light breeze
 and pleasant latter by obs 30.36

Tuesday These 24 hours begins with light
 the 26 breeze from the S.W. ship under all sail
 Hoisting stowing S.W. all the work
 6.41 employed at Coasting Room at 5 P.M.
 sent up the fore topmast stowing sail
 Booms and set the fore topmast stowing
 sail Hoisting Part light breeze latter
 Part the latter by obs 30.25

Wednesday These 24 hours begins with fine
 breeze from the Eastern ship under
 the 27 all sail S. by W. work employed on
 ships duty Hoisting sails on deck
 the fore mast and sent another one at
 5 P.M. wear the oil at 11 P.M. such
 6.45 in the fore topmast stowing sail
 at 6 A.M. wind holding to the S.W.
 sent up the yards sent the fore
 topmast sail latter part fine
 breeze so ends latter by obs 30.45

Thursday These 24 hours begins with fine
 the 28 breeze from the S.W. ship under
 all sail S. by W. work employed
 on ships duty middle part fine
 breeze and slightly at 4 A.M. Hoisting at
 9 A.M. such in the main topmast sail
 latter part light breeze and fine weather
 so ends this day latter by obs 30.45

Friday These 24 hours begins with light
 the 29 breeze from the S.W. ship under
 all sail by the wind work employed
 on ships duty at 4 P.M. Jack ship
 to the weather middle part light
 breeze and cloudy weather at 6 A.M.
 6.50 calm at 6 A.M. Jack ship to the S.W.
 East at 6 A.M. wind held to the S.W. set the
 fore topmast stowing sail latter
 Part fine breeze latter by obs 30.30

Saturday These 24 hours begins with fine
 the 30 breeze from the S.W. ship under
 under all sail middle part light
 breeze and fine weather
 6.51 latter part continued the same
 East so ends these 24 hours
 latter by obs 30.25
