Thursday These 24 hours begins with light
breeze from the west the ship under
the 24 all sail heading and work employed
16.07 at Ships Duty at 4 PM saw a sail to
Longitude the eastward standing to the westward
34.44 Middle Part calm the ship set a
East like latter Part calm once or with
calm last by 6.55 South

Friday
Line These 24 hours commences with light
the 26 line and calm ship under all sail
Long Work Employed on Ships Duty one ship in
34.24 sight to the eastward at 7 PM wind
East Enquiring set the stowing sails on the
barboard side at 10 PM wind holding to the
S. E. shifted the stowing sails over on the
starboard side Middle Part fine breeze from
the E. & E at 10 PM set the fore topgallant
stowing sail at the main latter Part
fine breeze and fine weather one ship
in sight to the south last by 6.55

Saturday
Sunday These 24 hours begins with fish breeze
the 27 E. & E ship under all sail work employed
Longitude on Ships Duty at 3 PM wind continuing to
36.19 the southward shifted the stowing sails
over on the barboard side sent the fore
topgallant stowing sail forward Middle
Part fish breeze at 9 AM sent the fore
topgallant stowing sail up off latter Part
strong breeze last by 6.55 South

Sunday
Monday These 24 hours begins strong breeze
the 28 from the E. & E ship under all sail
work employed on Ships Duty at one
Longitude PM shifted the stowing sails at 4 PM
27.43 sent the fore at 10 PM shifted the fore
East topgallant stowing sail off Middle
and latter Part fine breeze last 36.54 South

Monday These 24 hours begins with light
Sunday breeze from the S. E. at one PM wind
the 29 holding to the S. E. breast up sharp
buck in the stowing sails ship head
Longitude S. W. at 7 PM single huff the
28.06 topgallant at 8 PM double huff the topgallant
Middle Part fish gales from the S. E.
at 8 AM buck in the gib and mainsail
and cleast huff the topgallant at 6 AM
set the gib and main sail at 7 AM set
one huff out each topgallant at 11 AM buck
one huff in the main topgallant latter
Part fish gales last by 6.55

Tuesday
Monday These 24 hours begins with fish gales
the 30 from the S. E. and heavy sea running at
one PM moderate set hole topgallant at
2 PM set the main topgallant sail at
Longitude 4 PM stand S. W. set the fore topgallant
28.06 sail at 4 PM set the fore topmast stowing
East sail Middle Part calm at 6 AM a light
breeze from the E. & E at 6 AM shifted
the stowing sails at 8 AM wind enquiring
of latter Part fish breeze last by 6.55

Wednesday These 24 hours begins with strong
Monday breeze from the E. & E ship under
the 31 all sail. Sailing work employed on
Ships Duty at 5 PM wind holding fish
buck in the stowing sails at 6 PM
Main Cape aquilles running S. E. dist-
ance 40 miles bold up S. E. at 4 PM cleast
Longitude huff the topgallant buck in the fore and
28.11 Mizzen topgallant and gib and main sail
East and wore ship head off South at 11 mid
Longitude Night wore ship in to the S. E. W. S.
20.41 at 6 AM head sail at 9 AM set stowing
sails latter Part light breeze at 10
Main part calm Cap 36.54 West last 36.54
