Thursday These 24 hours begins with light
 S.W. breeze from the S.W. ship under
 1. the all ship running for the Cape at
 18.38 Good Hope all the waste employed get
 ting ready for bending the chains
 at 6 P.M. Cap of Good Hope there to
 Compt. N.C. B. B. B. 6 miles ship
 running S.W. at 7 P.M. sunk in the
 stern sails and run S.W. at 8 P.M.
 Stead. N.W. to Middle Port light breeze
 sunk in the fore and main topgallant
 sail held up the main and fore sail
 held off south at 4 A.M. wore ship in
 show and main all sail at dawn this
 saw the ship Briton of Plymouth at
 6 A.M. foggy hold of show at 7 saw the
 lane this in Bent the chains just
 the anchors clear at 8 A.M. calm
 latter Part calm latter by obs 84.04 South
 at 8 P.M. began towing in with
 three boats at 7 P.M. came to
 anchor in Cape Town in 44 fath-
 oms off water with the small anchor
 11.30 10 fathoms off Chain out
 hauled the sails at 8 P.M. wind
 springing up from the S.E. and blew
 very hard at 12 midnight light
 breeze to ender the day's work 36 hours

 the 2 This day begins with light breeze
 from the S.E. ship lying in Captown
 at 8 A.M. wind held in from the
 S.W. Capt Little went on shore at
 11 A.M. brought off 5 cask of water
 at 1 P.M. brought off 6 cask of water
 at 6 P.M. S.E. wind set in the harbor
 Newton Capt Katheraway went out
 at 7 P.M. strong within latter Part
 calm so ended this day

Saturday This day begins with light
 S.W. breeze from the S.E. at 4 A.M.
 the 3 one back went on shore on liberty
 18.38 Wash on shore employed craping
 the ship and taking in water at 5
 P.M. ship under Capt Gifford went
 out and the ship hauled at 7 P.M. wind
 out to the S.E. so ended this day

Sunday
 Feb 12
 the 4 These 24 hours begins with light
 breeze from the S.W. ship lying in
 Table Bay one wash on liberty
 show Richard Price 48 hours
 at 7 A.M. hauled the ship for Black
 Middle Port light breeze and fine
 weather at 8 P.M. sunk in yard show they
 and bread Potatoes on shore at 9 P.M. calm

Monday
 Feb 13
 the 5 This day begins with light breeze from
 the S.W. ship lying in Table Bay one wash
 on shore on liberty Middle Port light
 breeze and pleasant latter Part the same

Tuesday
 Feb 14
 the 6 These 24 hours begins with light breeze
 from the westward ship lying at Table
 Bay Cape Town one wash on shore
 on liberty Middle Port light breeze
 latter Part S.W. wind so ended

Wednesday
 Feb 15
 the 7 This day begins with a fresh breeze
 from the westward ship lying in
 Table Bay Captown. so liberty to day
 Capt on shore getting ready for sea
 latter Part strong breeze so ended

Thursday
 Feb 16
 the 8 This day begins with fresh breeze
 from the westward ship lying in
 Table Bay at 4 P.M. Capt Little came
 off hove ahead at 5 P.M. out Chain again
