Oct 25th 1870. Three H. hovers begins with a fine
breeze from the NW and cloudy ship
under all sail. Heavy swell. Empty,
no ships duty at 6 PM. Squally with
ship to the westward at 4 PM. Saw
no whales soon and shot did not strike.
Latter part fine. Three to four

Oct 26 There 1 1/2 hours Coms with a slight
breeze from the SW and fair weather.
Ship under all sail at 2 PM. Saw
Whale board and shaft but did not get it.

Boat and at 9 P.M. wind blowing up
to the N.E. then S.W. 13 & latter Part
Frisch Breeze and large weather to Ende
Latt Day old 33:23 Long in 24:37 W

Saturday the 27. Breeze begins with rain ...
at the 27 Breeze from the N.E. ship under all
sail steering S.W. 13 & work employed
in ships Casts. Huddles that give way
at 3 Am wind larks to the N.E. latter
Part light winds and thick & cloudy
thick light showers off shore to Ende

Monday
Oct 28th These 24 hours commencing with
a light breeze from the S.E. and abating
ship under all sail by the wind
Bore hails, in light breeze. Part light
breezes latter part calmer our sail in
light. Shows English Gulls in Crows

Oct 29 There is heavy snow with colds. Ship
under all sail and went to the Narrows
Tahara and Point - another Middle
Point light - Bays from the NW.
