and variable ship under all sail wack
employed on ships duty at 4 PM saw
whale leave the boat and not strike
Middle Part light breeze at 6 AM
saw the land bearing SE 3/4 S Distance
30 miles Latter Part light breeze so ends
Lat by obs 50° 28' S South
Long in 61° 38' W

gib and main sail at 3 AM close the
the main topsail at 5 AM close the
the fore topsail at 8 AM brought to anchor
let out the fore topsail and set the gib
and main sail at 18 Merino Gasket ship
to the SE Lat by obs 50° 54' S Long 62° 42' W

Sunday

from the NW and fair weather ship under
all sail stowing sent down several fine hanks
Middle Part strong breeze and fine weather
at 6 AM made the land bearing SE
Distance 40 miles Latter Part fine breeze
Lat by obs 54° 28' S Long in 64° 32' W
