

Ship Mousalee off Warren

Wednesday These 24 hours Come with light January breeze from the NW ship under the 8 all sail work Employed in ship duty Row sail in light Middle Port fish breeze and fair weather Latter Port fish breeze so ends Lat by obs 57° 14' N Long 76° 15'

Thursday These 24 hours Come with brisk breeze from the NW ship under single reef fore and mizen topsails steering SW Middle Port light breeze and fair weather at 4 PM let one reef out each topsail and set the main topgallant sail Latter Port Squally Lat by obs 57° 18' N Long in 76° 10' W

Friday Jan 10 These 24 hours Come with light breeze and variable ship under all sail by two wind steering NW work Employed Middle Port Calm at 7 PM saw ships to SW and one sperm whale board fore boater did not strike Latter Port fish breeze so ends this day Lat by account 57° 50' Long 76° 50' S ends

Saturday Jan 11 These 24 hours Come with brisk breeze from the ESE and thick weather ship under all sail steering west Middle Port fish breeze and thick weather at any light saw ships steering SW Latter Port fish breeze from the SE and thick weather Lat by obs 57° 59' Long 76° 04' West

Sunday These 24 hours Come with strong wind Jan 12 the SE and thick weather ship under all sail steering SW Middle Port breeze weather at 8 AM saw several humpback whales Latter Port fish breeze and cloudy so ends Lat by obs 58° 15' Long 76° 44' West

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Monday These 24 hours Come with brisk January breeze from the SW and breeze the 13 weather ship under all sail steering NW Middle Port fish breeze and thick weather at 6 AM saw a sail steering SE at 10 AM Calm afterwards Latter Port cloudy weather Lat by obs 57° 06' South Long in 77° 13' West

Tuesday These 24 hours Come with fine breeze from the NW and cloudy weather ship under all sail at 1 PM Calm afterwards Middle Port fish breeze and thick weather at 6 AM saw right whale at 7 PM board fore boater struck and held at 9 PM began cutting Latter Port fish breeze and cloudy so ends this day Lat by obs 49° 24' Long

Wednesday January the 15 all hands Employed in cutting at 3 PM finished cutting at 4 PM board fore boater struck and held at 5 PM took the whale to the ship and took in sail and ship in light at 6 PM set the work by line Middle Port fish breeze at 6 PM began cutting Latter Port ends with uprisings breeze so ends this day

Thursday Jan the 16 These 24 hours Come with a strong breeze from the SE at 5 PM fresh in sail began working at 6 PM Harry could board set the work boater crew at 8 PM began moving down wind at the south end by line Latter Port heavy gale and squally attended with rain so ends this day so ends

Friday Jan the 17 These 24 hours Come with heavy gale from the south and squally at 3 AM shifted the fore sail all hands Employed in working Middle Port Morden at 8 AM set the fore and mizen topsails Latter Port ends with a fish breeze Lat by obs 49° 26' N Long in 78° 55' W
