Feb 6 These 24 hours came with a fresh breeze
from the S & W ship under all sail
Strong N & W Middle Part thick weather
at 5 AM set the main sail at 9 AM
Tuck in the main sail at 10 PM. Tuck
in the fore and Mizen Topsail Latter
Part fish breeze. No ob. this day

Friday

Feb 7 These 24 hours began with a fresh breeze
from the W & W and thick weather at one
PM set the fore and Mizen Topsail and
main sail mizen Part calm. Latter part
light breeze so ended. No ob. this day

Saturday These 24 hours came with a fresh breeze
Feb 8 from the S & W at 4 PM. Squally. Sailed in
all sail except the lower Mast main
Topsail at 5 PM set the fore sail. Head 4.40
Middle Part fish breeze at 5 AM. Mizen
all sail. Latter part fine breeze and pleasant
S. E. wind. Lat 44.35 Long in 70.17 West

Sunday

Feb 9 These 24 hours came with a light breeze
from the S & W ship under all sail strong
N & W all the week employed on craping
Mizen Middle Part calm at 1 AM light
breeze from the W & W. Latter part ended
the same. Lat 44.35 Long in 70.31 West

Monday

Feb 10 These 24 hours came with slight breeze
from the W & W and pleasant weather
Ship under all sail by the wind
Middle Part light breeze and pleasant
weather. Latter part continued the same.
Lat 44.35 Long in 70.35 West

Tuesday

Feb 11 These 24 hours came with slight breeze
from the W & W and pleasant weather ship
under all sail strong N & W all the
employed landing up top galley mast
Middle Part light breeze. Latter part
continued the same. No ob. this day
Lat 44.35 Long in 70.24 West

Wednesday

Feb 12 These 24 hours came with a light breeze
from the W & W ship under all sail
week employed on ships duty. Mizen
Part light breeze at 12 Tuck ship to the S & W
at 5 AM. Mizen the island of Mowing North
about 12 miles saw 2 ships the first 4 miles
off. Arrived at 11 minutes. 16.00. Well in the track
of the Bedford 7 minutes. 16.10. At 10 AM the boat
went on shore so ended.
