

Ship "Miracle" off Warren

Thursday Feb the 13. 1880

These 24 hours came with light breeze and calm at 5 PM made all sail and stood N 73 W at 9 PM hazy fog off wind and then double drift the schooner continued the same breeze latter part continued the same

Friday Feb the 14

These 24 hours came with fresh breeze from the S E and fine weather ship under all sail work employed on ships duty at 7 PM hush in sail and let the work boats come at 5 AM made sail and stood N 73 W latter part fresh breeze and fine weather

Saturday Feb the 15

These 24 hours came with fresh breeze from the S E and fine weather ship under all sail work employed on ships duty at 7 PM hush in sail and let the work boat N 73 W Middle Port fine breeze at 5 PM made sail and stood N 73 W 40 latter part fine breeze so ends latter by obs 29.31' Long in 78.21' 42

Sunday Feb the 16

These 24 hours came with fresh breeze from the S E and fine weather ship under all sail work employed on ships duty at 7 PM hush in sail and let the work Middle Port light breeze at 5 AM made sail and stood N 73 W 40 latter part fine breeze and fine weather at 4 PM latter by obs 29.19' Long in 78.18' 42

Monday Feb the 17

These 24 hours came with fresh breeze from the S E and pleasant weather ship under all sail standing N 73 W 40 at 4 PM hush in sail and let the work Middle Port light breeze at 5 AM made all sail latter part fine breeze and pleasant weather latter by obs 28.58' Long 78.18' 42

Continued 1880

Tuesday Feb the 18 These 24 hours came with light breeze and pleasant weather ship under all sail standing N 73 W all the work employed on ships duty Middle Port light breeze at 2 AM calm at 4 PM light breeze from the S E latter part light breeze and pleasant latter by obs 28.46' Long 78.16' 42

Wednesday Feb the 19

These 24 hours came with light breeze from the S E ship under all standing N 73 W at 6 PM hush in sail and Middle Port light breeze at 4 AM variable latter part light winds latter by obs 28.15' Long in 78

Thursday Feb the 20

These 24 hours came with fresh breeze from the S E and fine weather ship under all sail standing N 73 W at 3 PM saw an sperm whale she went down and that is the last off her Middle Port light breeze latter part continued the same so ends

Friday Feb the 21

These 24 hours came with light breeze from the S E and variable ship under all sail standing N 73 W all the work employed on ships duty Middle Port light breeze and fine weather so ends latter by obs 28.31'

Saturday Feb the 22

These 24 hours came with fresh breeze from the S E and fine weather ship under all sail work employed on ships duty Middle Port light breeze and cloudy latter part ends the same so ends latter by obs 28.57' Long in 78.25' 42

Sunday Feb the 23

These 24 hours came with fresh breeze from the S E and passing cloudy ship standing N 73 W Middle Port fine breeze latter part the same latter by obs 28.10' Long
