Monday Feb the 24. 1880 Thru 24 hours calm.
With a breeze from the S.E. and passing
clouds ship under all sail steering North
at 5 P.M. saw a school of black fish between
Mexico Port fish Bay latter part
Continued the same Lat 11.35 Long 78.67

Tuesday Feb the 25
Thru 24 hours calm with a fine breeze
from the S.E. and fine weather ship
under all sail steering N.W. with employ
on ships duty Mexico Port fish Bay
Latter part continued the same S. End
Lat 11.31 Long 79.52

Wednesday Feb the 26
Thru 24 hours calm with a fine breeze
from the S.E. and fine weather ship under
all sail with employ on ships
duty ships duty Mexico Port
Latter part light breeze Lat 11.31 Long 79.52

Thursday Feb the 27
Thru 24 hours calm with light breeze
from the S.E. and pleasant weather
ship under all sail Mexico Port
light breeze latter part continued
the same Lat 11.31 Long 80.52

Friday Feb the 28
Thru 24 hours calm with a light breeze
from the S.E. and hazy weather ship under
all sail with employ on ships duty
the land in light breeze at 8 P.M. the
Mexico Port light breeze and fine weather
Long 81.52 On Light latter part calm

Saturday March the 1
Thru 24 hours calm with light breeze
at 3 P.M. Capt. came on board ship in
the harbor at 5 P.M. came to anchor in
6 fathoms off water with 40 fathoms off
beam out held the shells in water and
latter part pleasant weather Pye

Sunday Feb the 29 This day begins with
light breeze and pleasant weather
in day and work on the ship
Mexico and latter part calm pleasant

Monday March the 2
This day calm with fine weather
all hands employed on ships duty
Mexico and latter part calm pleasant

Tuesday March the 3
This day begins with fine weather
all hands employed on ships duty
Mexico and latter part calm fine weather

Wednesday March the 4
This day calm with light breeze from
the S.W. all hands employed on getting in
oil landed 12 barrels S. End

Thursday March the 5
Thru 24 hours calm with fine breeze
from the S.E. the more than morning
Mexico and latter part calm pleasant

Friday March the 6
Thru 24 hours calm with light breeze
from the S.E. all hands employed
on ships duty getting ready for sea but
have not yet the men with the
Crew with fine breeze and pleasant weather

Saturday March the 7
This day begins with light breeze ship
all ready for sea at 4 P.M. ship under
Calm in 24 fathoms out and 40 fathoms off
latter part calm with light breeze

Sunday March the 8
This day calm with light breeze at 1 P.M.
brought the anchor and then went to sea
Mexico Port light breeze and fine
weather latter part the same
Lat 11.31 Long 81.52
