at 5 AM set the fore and main

Thursday April the 23

Saturday April the 25
These 24 hours came with a fine breeze
from the S.E. and passing clouds
ship under all sail wack employed
on ship duty Middle part light
breeze and passing clouds at 6 AM
long 124° 10' of same latter part fine
weather latter by obs 55.5° Long 125° 49' W
Sunday April the 26
These 24 hours came with a fine breeze
from the S.E. ship under all sail
wack employed on ship duty
Middle part fine breeze latter part fine
breeze latter by obs 55.5° Long 126° 40' W
Monday April the 27
These 24 hours came with a fine breeze
from the S.E. and fine weather ship
under all sail storing W.S.W. Middle
part fine breeze and light showers off
shore latter part light showers off
shore so ends this day
latter by obs 55.5° Long 127° 40' W

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Tuesday April the 23 1840
These 24 hours came with a fine breeze
from the S.E. and cloudy weather ship
under all sail storing W.S.W. wack
employed on setting up shocker pipe
at 6 AM took in main sail and
likewise shifted the spritsails Middle
part fine wind at 6 AM main sail
latter part fine breeze so ends
latter by obs 55° 20' S Long 125° 17' W
Wednesday April the 29
These 24 hours came with a fine breeze
from the S.E. ship under all sail
storing W.S.W. wack employed on
setting up shocker and other jobs
at 6 AM shortened sail Middle part
fine breeze at 6 AM main sail latter
part fine breeze and pleasant weather
latter by obs 55.5° S Long 125° 46' W
Thursday April the 30
These 24 hours came with a fine breeze
from the S.E. and pleasant weather
ship under all sail storing W.S.W. and
several boats hauled at 6 AM shortened
sail Middle part fine breeze at 6 AM
main sail latter part fine weather
latter by obs 55.5° south Long 126° 02' W
Friday April the 1 May the 1
These 24 hours came with a fine
breeze from the S.E. ship under
all sail storing W.S.W. at 6 AM saw what
board two boats struck 2 what barbed
boat broad west boat struck and died
at 6 PM took the whale to the ship
Middle part fine weather at 6 AM began
cutting at 8 AM finished at 10 AM began
hogging latter part cloudy so ends
so at this day
