

Ship Houslie off Warren 1840

Saturday May the 2 1840

Three 24 hours came with a light breeze from the Eastward and cloudy sky under all sail all hands employed on voyaging at 6 PM Shorter sail at midnight finished voyaging at 6 AM. Mail sent latter part first breeze so ended. Lat 43° 05' N Long 138° 01' W

Sunday May the 3d

Three 24 hours came with a fine breeze from the Eastward ship under all sail work employed on ship's duty at 12 midnight hove aback at 6 AM. Mail sent at 8 AM. Mail one off the island bearing 10° 45' S distance 20 miles. How often islands in sight Lat 43° 05' N Long 138° 21' W

Monday May the 4

Three 24 hours came with a fine breeze from the Eastward ship under all sail stood down 19 barrels off oil. How often islands in sight. Middle Port light breeze at 6 AM. Mail sent and stood in. How the land at 8 AM. Pilot came on board latter part ended with a fine breeze. Tuesday May the 5

at one PM Capt. went on ship at 4 PM came on board. Went the chain and in for the Port and marked at 6 PM came to anchor in 18 fathoms water with 50 fathoms of chain out. Middle Port light breeze at 8 AM. Sent 2 Boats working. So ended.

Wednesday May the 6 This day came with a fine breeze at 8 AM. Sent a raft of cashmere show water at 12. Came off at 2 PM. Hove in. Latter part all hands employed in stowing down so ended. This day. Dredged man off. How came in Port on the 7th.

New Beaver May 1840

Thursday May the 7 This day came with a fine breeze all hands employed working and painting ship and fitting off. Middle Port fine breeze latter part continued the same. So ended.

Friday May the 8 Three 24 hours came with a light breeze from the SW. The ship in. How often all hands employed painting the ship latter part. How so ended. This day.

Saturday May the 9 This day came with a light breeze from the SW. The ship in. How often waiting around that has been. How latter part light breeze and pleasant weather. So ended.

Sunday May the 10 1840

This day came with light winds and variable. The ship in. How often waiting for news. Middle Port very warm. Latter part. How. Tinned the same. So ended.

Monday May the 11

Thursday came with a fine breeze and fine weather. The ship in. How often all hands employed on ship's duty. Middle Port. Latter part. How the same.

Tuesday May the 12

This day came with a light breeze from the SW. at 6 AM. Mail sent. The ship in. How often the anchors at 8 AM. The ship came to anchor of New Bedford came in within 12 AM. How at 10.

Wednesday May the 13

at 4 PM. Mail sent and stood in. The ship at 9 AM. How often the anchors. Latter part light breeze and variable. So ended. This day. The ship in.
