

Ship Mosaic of Warren

Saturday June the 13. 1840

These 24 hours commenced with fresh breeze ship under single reef. The topsails standing to the Northward nothing in sight at 6 PM fresh in sail. Middle part fresh breeze at 5 AM main sail at 6 AM saw a black store off shore but saw nothing. Latter part fresh breeze lat 45° 40' Long 115° 47'

Sunday June the 14

These 24 hours commenced with strong trade and passing clouds ship under single reef. Topsails standing to the Northward at 6 PM fresh in sail. Middle part fresh breeze and squally at 5 AM main sail at 6 AM fresh in sail and squally at 11 AM the topsails standing to the Northward. Latter part fresh breeze lat 45° 40' Long 115° 47'

Monday June the 15

These 24 hours commenced with fresh breeze ship under all topsails standing to the Northward at 6 PM fresh in sail. Middle part fresh breeze at 5 AM main sail at 6 AM fresh in sail. Latter part light squally lat 45° 40' Long 115° 47'

Tuesday June the 16

These 24 hours commenced with fresh breeze and passing clouds with light squally nothing in sight at 6 PM fresh in sail. Middle part light breeze and squally ship to the South at 5 AM main sail at 6 AM squally fresh in the breeze. Topsails latter part continued the same. Lat 45° 40' Long 115° 47'

Wednesday June the 17

These 24 hours commenced with fresh breeze from the East ship head 8° E at 6 PM fresh in sail. Middle part squally at 5 AM set the fore and main topsails lat 45° 40' Long 115° 47'

Thursday June the 18

These 24 hours commenced with fresh breeze and light squally ship under double reef. Topsails standing to the Southward at 6 PM fresh in sail. Middle part light breeze and fair weather at 5 AM main sail at 6 AM heavy shower off shore. Latter part fresh breeze lat 45° 40' Long 115° 47'

Friday June the 19

These 24 hours commenced with fresh breeze and fair weather ship under single reef. Topsails were employed on ships duty. Middle part light breeze at 5 AM main sail at 6 AM fresh in sail. Latter part fresh breeze lat 45° 40' Long 115° 47'

Saturday June the 20

These 24 hours commenced with light breeze and passing clouds ship under all sail by the wind were employed on ships duty. Middle part fresh breeze at 5 AM squally at 6 AM had a most amusing time fore and latter part ended with fine breeze and pleasant weather. Lat 45° 40' Long 115° 47'

Sunday June the 21

These 24 hours commenced with fine breeze and passing clouds ship under all sail. Standing 8° E at 6 PM squally fresh in the fore and main topsails. Middle part light breeze at 5 AM set all sails. Latter part fine breeze. Lat 45° 40' Long 115° 47'

Monday June the 22

These 24 hours commenced with fine breeze ship under all sail. Standing 8° E at 6 PM squally. Middle part light breeze. Latter part strong breeze and passing clouds. Lat 45° 40' Long 115° 47'
